

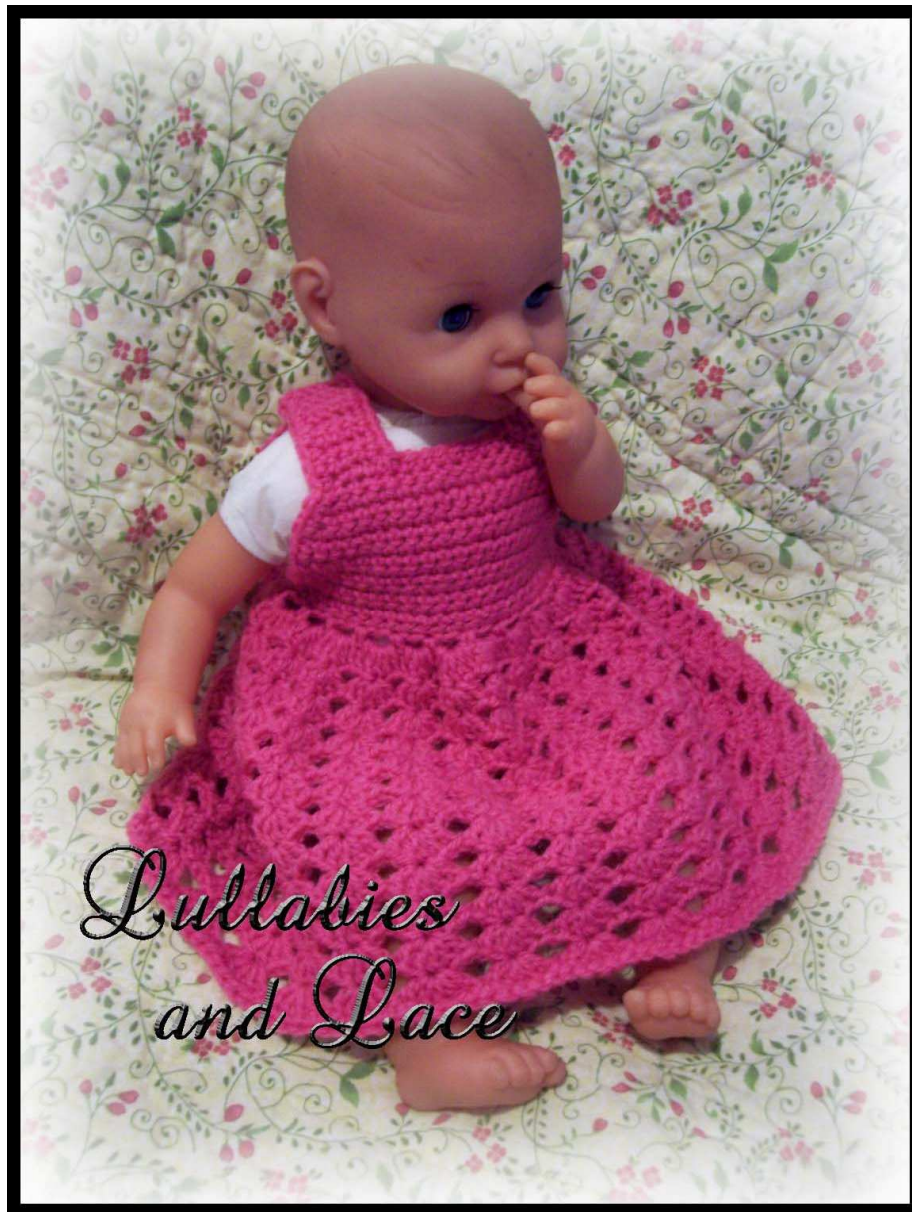
Delightfully Pink Baby Doll Dress

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Delightfully Pink Baby Doll Dress

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Supplies:

- Approx. 2-3 oz. Bernat Baby Sport weight yarn
- Size "G" (4.0 mm) crochet hook (or size needed to obtain gauge)
- Needle for weaving in ends

Skill Level:

Easy

Gauge:

Row 1 – ch 21, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. –(20 sc)-

Rows 2-5 – Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across. –(20 sc)-

5 sc = 1"

4 rows = 1"

Size Info:

This dress fits a standard 14"-16" baby doll

Chest 9 ½"

Shoulder to ankle 10 ½"

Notes:

End counts are given for each row in parentheses. –()-

Option for a smaller shoulder strap is given in red.

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Bodice Front

Row 1 – Ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. –(16 sc)- MARK AS RIGHT SIDE.

Row 2 – Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc. –(18 sc)-

Row 3 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc and in each sc across. –(18 sc)-

Row 4 – Repeat Row 2. –(20 sc)-

Rows 5-10 – Repeat Row 3. FASTEN OFF. –(20 sc)-

Customization Option: Repeat Row 10 until piece measures desired length before joining.

Bodice Back

Row 1 – Ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. –(16 sc)- MARK AS RIGHT SIDE.

Row 2 – Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc. –(18 sc)-

Row 3 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc and in each sc across. –(18 sc)-

Row 4 – Repeat Row 2. –(20 sc)-

Rows 5-10 – Repeat Row 3. Do NOT Fasten Off. –(20 sc)-

Customization Option: Repeat Row 10 until piece measures same as Bodice Front.

Joining

Rnd 1 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc and in each sc across Bodice Back, with Right Side facing, sc in each sc across Bodice Front, join with sl st to first sc of Bodice Back.
–(40 sc)-

Rnd 2 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to first sc. –(40 sc)-
Customization Option: Repeat Rnd 2 until Bodice measures desired length.

Skirt

Rnd 1 – Ch 1, sc in same sc, ch 2, *sk 1 sc, sc in next sc, ch 2, repeat from * around, ch 1, sc in first sc to form last ch-2 loop. –(20 ch-2 loops)-

Rnd 2 – Ch 2 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 2 dc in same ch-2 loop, *5 dc in next ch-2 loop, repeat from * around, 2 dc in same loop as first 3 dc, join with sl st to first dc. –(20 5-dc shells)-

Rnds 3-13 – Ch 2, 2 dc in same dc, *5 dc in center dc of next 5-dc shell, repeat from * around, 2 dc in same dc as first 3 dc, join with sl st to first dc. –(20 5-dc shells)-

Rnd 14 – Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each dc around, join with sl st to first sc. FASTEN OFF. –(100 sc)-

Customization Option: Repeat Rnd 14 until Skirt measures desired length. Dress pictured measures from shoulder to ankle at 10 ½ “after shoulder straps were added.

Shoulder Straps (wider strap option)

Row 1 – With Right Side of Front facing, join yarn with sl st to first sc at top corner of bodice, ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 3 sc. –(4 sc)-

Rows 2-11 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc and in each sc across. –(4 sc)-

Customization Option: Repeat Row 11 until strap measures desired length.

Row 12 – With Right Sides together, matching scs from strap and Bodice Back, sl st through both to join in each sc across, turn work, sc evenly around armhole opening.
–(4 sl st)-

Repeat for Left Strap starting at Bodice Back and ending at Bodice Front.

Shoulder Straps (smaller strap option)

Row 1 – With Right Side of Front facing, join yarn with sl st to first sc at top corner of bodice, ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 2 sc. –(3 sc)-

Rows 2-11 – Ch 1, turn, sc in same sc and in each sc across. –(3 sc)-

Customization Option: Repeat Row 11 until strap measures desired length.

Row 12 – With Right Sides together, matching scs from strap and Bodice Back, sl st through both to join in each sc across, turn work, sc evenly around armhole opening. – (3 sl st)-

Repeat for Left Strap starting at Bodice Back and ending at Bodice Front.

Neckline Edging

Attach yarn with sl st to any sc in center of Bodice Back neckline, ch 1, sc in same st, *sc in each sc to 1 sc before corner, insert hook in last sc before corner and pull up a loop, insert hook in corner and pull up a loop, insert hook in side of first row on strap and pull up a loop, YO and pull through all 4 loops on hook, repeat from * around, sc in each remaining sc to first sc, join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off. Weave in Ends.
