Michigan State - Kentucky Series

The Series: Michigan State and Kentucky have met 20 times on the hardwood, with the Wildcats holding a slim 11-9 advantage. The Spartans, however, have won three of the last four meetings since 1999.

Last Season: MSU defeated UK, 71-67, on Dec. 14, 2002 at Rupp Arena in Lexington, Ky.

Coaches

Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan '77)

- 189-78 (.708) overall record in eight seasons as a head coach
- Guided MSU to 2000 NCAA Championship and three straight Final Fours (1999-2001), making him one of just two
 active coaches to win a national championship and appear in three straight Final Fours
- Led MSU to four straight regular-season Big Ten Championships (1998-2001) and back-to-back Big Ten Tournament titles (1999 & 2000)
- Earned National Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 1999 and 2001
- 1998 Big Ten Coach of the Year
- Highest NCAA Tournament winning percentage (.792) among active coaches
- 189 wins in first eight seasons rank fourth best in college basketball history

Kentucky Head Coach Tubby Smith (High Point '73)

- 288-109 (.725) overall record in 12 seasons as a head coach
- 164-47 (.777) record in six seasons as head coach at Kentucky
- Guided UK to the 1998 NCAA Championship in his first year with the Wildcats
- Led the Wildcats to four regular-season SEC Championships (1998, 2000, 2001, 2003) and four SEC Tournament titles (1998, 1999, 2001, 2003)
- 288 wins in his first 12 seasons rank fourth best in college basketball history
- Earned National Coach of the Year honors in 1998 and 2003
- 1998 and 2003 SEC Coach of the Year
