PHILLIP HATCHETT

**FIRST SEASON
ALMA MATER: WKU, 1985**

WKU Director of Intercollegiate Athletics Ross Bjork announced on August 26, 2010, the hiring of Phillip Hatchett as full-time head men's golf coach at Western Kentucky University.

A 1985 graduate of Western Kentucky University and four-year member of the golf team, Hatchett brings with him to his current role 14 years of PGA Tour experience on the Canadian, South African and South American tours and 24 years of experience as a golf instructor.

"I am very much looking forward to the opportunity to take WKU's men's golf program to another level," Hatchett said. "The student-athletes on this team are going to be a great group to work with, and I look forward to getting started with them. I am very excited about the opportunity to get WKU back at the top of the Sun Belt Conference standings."

"We are thrilled to name Phillip Hatchett as our men's golf coach," Bjork said. "He was a student-athlete, is part of our community, played at the highest level as a professional and has extensive experience as a golf instructor over the last 24 years. His golf academy and junior golf camp series have had a positive impact on countless young golfers, which provides a unique perspective to recruiting the best and brightest to WKU. In addition, his 14 year career as a professional golfer has enabled him to establish a number of valuable and important contacts, and he knows what is required to compete at the sport's highest level. As a WKU graduate, Phillip is the ideal individual to impact our men's program in a manner that results in WKU golf achieving the level of success it deserves."

While on the foreign PGA Tour from 1986-2000 Hatchett won nine tournaments, including three-straight Irving Cobb titles and back-to-back Quebec Open championships. He also captured the 1990 Vancouver Open crown and the 1992 Canadian Tournament Players Championship, as well as added five top-three finishes in various other foreign PGA Tour events.

"I am very excited about the hiring of Phillip Hatchett, and I really feel WKU got it right with this hire," former WKU golf teammate of Hatchett and 28-year PGA Tour veteran Kenny Perry said. "The players under Phillip will learn so much from his teaching abilities and his playing background. I am so glad WKU has made a commitment to the golf programs and hired a true 'Western' man for the job, and I look forward to continuing to see WKU get back to being a top program."

"We knew this would be an attractive job once we made the decision to move this position to full-time status," said Pam Herriford, WKU Associate Athletics Director and Chair of the Golf Search Committee. "We were very pleased with the top-flight pool of candidates we received, which included both current head coaches and some top assistants. Phillip's total body of work and package of unique experiences made him the right choice to be the head men's golf coach at WKU."

In addition, Hatchett created the Phillip Hatchett Junior Golf Camp in 2008 in an effort to stimulate the game of golf among younger players in the south-central Kentucky area. The Phillip Hatchett Junior Golf Camp has seen over 200 young golfers in its existence.

Hatchett and his wife, Beth, reside in Russellville.

2009-10 (JUNIOR SEASON): Member of the Hilltopper golf team in 2009-10.

KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY: As a sophomore in 2007-08, Alred posted a 73.7 stroke average in 18 rounds, third best on the Owls squad...In six events, he recorded four top 20's with a career-best finish of tied for 12th at the Mizuno Southbridge Intercollegiate on October 15-16...Career-best round of 66 came in round two of the Sam Hall Intercollegiate on November 5-6, placing tied for 19th.

XAVIER UNIVERSITY: Competed in two events as a freshman at Xavier, registering a 76.33 scoring average with a season-best round of 69.

ETOWAH HIGH SCHOOL: As a junior in 2005, shot a one-over-par 72 to lead his high school to its second Georgia Class AAA State Championship...Finished third individually at the 2005 State Championship...Tied for 32nd at the 2006 Georgia Amateur...Carded rounds of 73-72-71 to finish seventh at the 2005 Georgia Junior Amateur.


ANTONIO BRUNA

2009-10 (JUNIOR SEASON): Played in one event in 2009-10, shooting a 240 in the UC Bearcat Invitational.

2008-09 (SOPHOMORE SEASON): Posted a 79.43 stroke average in 21 rounds of golf...Competed in seven events, the fourth most on the squad...His first career top 20 finish came at the Charleston Southern University Invitational on April 6-7 where he fired a career-low 71 in tying for 14th...Just four days later, Bruna registered back-to-back top 20's when he placed 16th at the UK Bluegrass Invitational on April 11-12 in Lexington, Ky...Recorded three rounds in the 70's to finish third amongst the Toppers in the Kauai Collegiate Cup on March 13-14 in Lihue, Hawaii.

2007-08 (FRESHMAN SEASON): Qualified for three tournaments in the spring as a rookie, logging nine rounds of competitive play...Compiled a 78.11 stroke average...Best finish of the season, tied for 56th, came in his collegiate debut at the MTSU/Aldila Intercollegiate on March 31-April 1...His best scoring tournament of the year came the following week, April 7-8, at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic in Scottsdale, Ariz. in which Bruna carded rounds of 73-75-72...The 72 was a season-best...Helped the Hilltoppers finish sixth out of 20 teams at the Cowboy Classic, their second-best showing of the season.

THE AMERICAN SCHOOL: Played his high school golf at The American School in San Jose, Costa Rica...Twice was the Costa Rica Junior National Champion, in 2004 and 2005...Member of the Junior National Team...Won the 2006 Amateur National Championship.

2009-10 (JUNIOR SEASON): One of the top performers for the Hilltoppers in 2009-10... Participated in 10 events, averaging a 74.00 over 30 rounds... Shot in the 70s in 29 of his 30 rounds... Won the Kauai Collegiate Cup with a three-round score of 221, WKU's only individual win of the season... Shot in the 60s in all three rounds of the Renaissance Invitational and finished fourth, opening with a 67... Shot 13-under par for the tournament... Finished strong in tournaments in 2009-10, averaging a 73.6 in third rounds.

2008-09 (SOPHOMORE SEASON): Finished second on the team in stroke average at 77.17...His 10 events played was second only to Adam McDonald's 11...Twice fired season-low rounds of 70, the first coming at the Kansas Invitational on September 16 and the second at the season-ending Sun Belt Conference Championships in Houston, Texas on April 22...His tied for 21st finish at the SBC Championships was best on the squad...Set a season-best, and tied a career-mark, for top finish when he tied for 12th at the Kansas Invitational following rounds of 76, 74, and 70...He was

second on the Toppers squad at both the Landfall Tradition on October 24-26 in Wilmington, N.C. and at the UK Bluegrass Invitational on April 11-12 in Lexington, Ky.

2007-08 (FRESHMAN SEASON): Transferred in mid-year and made an immediate impact, appearing in all five springs tournaments...Posted four top 20 finishes and was second in stroke average at 73.53, trailing only All-Conference golfer Brent Long...Ranked 17th in the Sun Belt Conference in scoring...Best tournament came on April 7-8 at the Cowboy Classic hosted by the University of Wyoming in Scottsdale, Ariz. after firing rounds of 71, 67, and 69 for a 207, tying for 12th...Also tied for 12th at the Kauai Collegiate Cup and the UK Bluegrass Invitational...At the MTSU Intercollegiate on March 31 and April 1, tied for 19th.

UMKC: Competing in the fall season for the Kangaroos, posted a pair of top five finishes...Registered 74.40 stroke average.

AMERICAN HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL: Won the individual 2005 Florida State High School Championship...Led team to the Florida runner-up as both a junior and senior...Two-time team Most Valuable Player...Stroke average of 72.00.

2008-09 (JUNIOR SEASON): Led the Hilltoppers in scoring with a 76.48 stroke average...Served as one of the team's co-captains...The only WKU golfer to compete in all 11 tournaments...Led the Toppers in scoring in five events...Turned in three top 20 finishes highlighted by his season-best tied for 15th finish at the season opening Cobb/Ferrell Mean Green Classic in Denton, Texas...Fired a second round 68...Tied for 17th at the Mission Inn Collegiate Classic in Howey-In-The-Hills, Fla., registering a final round 70...In the first tournament of the spring portion of the schedule, the Kauai Collegiate Cup, McDonald concluded the event with a career-best five-under-par 67 to tie for 20th.



RON BURCHETT**SECOND SEASON
ALMA MATER: WKU, 1994**

On August 31, 2010, WKU Director of Intercollegiate Athletics Ross Bjork announced the hiring of Ron Burchett as full-time head women's golf coach at Western Kentucky University.

Burchett has been on the Lady Topper golf staff for the past six seasons, starting on a volunteer basis for two seasons before becoming an assistant coach in 2006-07. After three years as an assistant coach, Burchett took the reins of the program as part-time head coach in February 2009, after Chuck Eison stepped down as head coach and became an assistant.

"This is a dream job for me," Burchett said. "I am honored to be part of a great university with such a rich history in athletics, to work with great student-athletes and the WKU athletics staff and to work beside Phillip Hatchett. As a golf coach, I am lucky to be in a community where golf is so popular. Bowling Green has everything to offer. I have thoroughly enjoyed working with the women's program

for the past few years, and I am excited about the opportunities I now have to take our WKU Lady Topper program to another level."

"Ron has performed admirably while previously leading our women's golf program under limited resources, and after interviewing a number of candidates there is no doubt he is the right person to lead the program into the future," Bjork said. "We have made a commitment to elevate our men's and women's golf programs by hiring full-time coaches, and I have total confidence in Ron's ability to make a significant impact on our women's program. His knowledge of our program and student-athletes coupled with his experience in the community will enable this to be a seamless transition. The best days for WKU golf lay ahead."

In his three seasons as an assistant coach at WKU, Burchett helped guide the Lady Toppers to seven top-five finishes, highlighted by victories at Eastern Kentucky and Butler.

Burchett piloted the Lady Toppers to three third-place finishes as head coach in 2009-10. Under Burchett's tutelage, Emily Wolff had the low individual score at the Murray State Invitational on September 14-15, 2009, helping the Lady Toppers to third place in the standings.

"We attracted an impressive group of candidates for this position," said Pam Herriford, WKU Associate Athletics Director and Chair of the Golf Search Committee. "We knew that making the women's golf head coaching position a full-time appointment would bring a talented pool of applicants. As we went through the interview process, we knew that Ron's experience with the WKU program as an assistant coach and part-time head coach, coupled with his familiarity with golf in south-central Kentucky made him the ideal candidate to lead the Lady Topper golf program into the future on a full-time basis."

A Glasgow, Ky., native, Burchett attended WKU from 1990-94 and currently assists in the coordination of golf clinics and camps for women and juniors in the area. Burchett himself is an outstanding golfer as well, as he won the 45th annual Par-Makers championship in Bowling Green in 2008.
