

2010-11 ACADEMIC CHAMPIONSHIP EFFORT!

- 85% of all student-athletes who have fulfilled their eligibility this decade have graduated.
- For all 387 WKU student-athletes, the overall cumulative average GPA is 3.0 and 224 student-athletes (58 %) are maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Ten of the university's 15 athletic programs have a cumulative team GPA of 3.0 or better.
- In the first semester of the 2010-11 year, 148 student-athletes (38%) had a grade point average of 3.4 or higher and earned recognition on the Dean's List or President's List, and at least one student-athlete from each of WKU's 15 sport programs made either the Dean's or President's List.
- WKU is one of only five Sun Belt Conference schools to exceed the NCAA required 925Academic Progress Report Rate (APR) in every men's and women's sport.
- A total of 22 WKU student-athletes representing 10 separate sports graduated in the December 18 commencement ceremonies, and a total of 105 student-athletes have graduated in the last calendar year, as 23 graduated in December of 2009 and 60 graduated in May of 2010.
- WKU has had more individuals honored by the league academically than any other institution in each of the last six years.
- WKU had a graduation success rate of 75% or greater in 14 of the 16 sports programs
 most recently measured by the NCAA and had a 100% graduation success rate in six
 sports.
- WKU graduated 59% of its student-athletes from the 2000-01 through 2003-04 freshman class, the most recent classes measured by the NCAA. The 59% graduation rate by WKU student-athletes was the second-highest in the Sun Belt Conference and also exceeded the 49% graduation rate posted by all WKU students during this time frame.
- WKU student-athletes in the university's 19 sports are majoring in 76 different programs. The Gordon Ford College of Business has 58 student-athletes, the most of any division.
