HEAD COACH TYRA PERRY

4th Season • Record at WKU 90-74
Overall Record: 236-272 (9 seasons)
Alma Mater: Louisiana State University (1997)
Hometown: Zachary, La.

Head coach Tyra Perry enters her fourth season leading the Lady Topper softball program. Perry led the 2010 team to a 27-25 overall record with 10 home victories at the WKU Softball complex.

In 2010, the Lady Toppers went on a nine-game winning streak from March 13-24, tying the longest winning streak in Lady Topper softball history which last happened during the 2007 season.

In Perry's third season, two Lady Toppers were named to the 2010 All-Sun Belt Conference Second Team with senior Lindsay Antone and freshman Mallorie Sulaski earning the honor. Antone was also named Sun Belt Conference player of the week along with Sulaski earning the award for Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week during her freshman campaign.

Perry's 2010 squad bid farewell to seven seniors who were a strong influence to the team on and off the field. Academically senior Shannon Smith was named to the Cosida ESPN The Magazine All-Academic First Team and WKU Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year. She also earned the prestigious Ogden Foundation Scholar Award, WKU's top academic honor.

Perry was named the 2009 Sun Belt Conference Co-Coach of the Year, after leading the 2009 Lady Toppers to a 35-19 record, finishing the season with a .648 winning percentage, the best in school history. Perry, who was introduced as WKU's head coach on August 27, 2007, has continued to stress the importance of excellence on and off the field.

In 2009, The Lady Toppers finished the season with series wins over Sun Belt Conference foes Louisiana-Lafayette, North Texas, South Alabama and Middle Tennessee while also picking up series sweeps during the regular season over Florida International and ULM. To end the season, the Lady Toppers finished the Sun Belt Conference Tournament with a 3-2 record after recording wins over Florida Atlantic, Troy and South Alabama.

Two Lady Toppers were named to the Sun Belt All-Conference Teams in 2009 with senior Terri Ellingsworth being named to the First Team and senior Ryan Rogge being named to the Second Team. Ellingsworth, who finished the season with a .308 batting average, led the team in batting average, homeruns (14) and RBIs (44) while Rogge finished her last season on the Hill with a 27-10 overall record and a 1.66 ERA after giving up just 58 earned runs in 40 appearances. Rogge was also named to the Sun Belt All-Tournament Team at the conclusion of the 2009 Tournament.

Perry also continued to stress the importance of academics with six Lady Toppers being named to the Sun Belt Conference Commissioner's List and eight Lady Toppers being named to the Academic Honor Roll. Rachelle Boucher, Ellingsworth, Jennifer Kempf, Brittney Perry, Shannon Smith and Amanda Walden finished the year with a 3.5 GPA or better and Elizabeth Ferrell, Amanda Ford-Feitz, Jamie Hennis, Kelsey McCauley, Brooke Reed, Rogge and Sara Williams finished with a 3.0 GPA or better.

In 2008, Perry guided the Lady Toppers to a 28-30 season record while leading WKU to five wins against teams ranked in the top 25. In addition, the Lady Toppers finished the season on a high note with wins against Middle Tennessee and Florida International in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

The WKU softball record books also saw quite a shuffle in 2007-08 with athletes breaking several season and career records. At the conclusion of the season, Perry's athletes picked up a number of elite honors led by Rebecca Horesky who was named to the All-Sun Belt First Team. The Lady Toppers also placed two athletes on the Sun Belt Tournament Team with Terri Ellingsworth and Rachelle Boucher picking up the honor.

The honors didn't stop there, Perry's athletes were also honored by numerous agencies for their academic achievements. Lauren Caudill, Kelsey McCauley, Shannon Smith and Shelby Smith were honored by the conference office by being named to the Commissioner's List and Samantha Cronk, Terri Ellingsworth, Elizabeth Ferrell, Jennifer Kempf and Ryan Rogge were honored on the Academic Honor Roll. In addition, Shannon Smith, Lindsay Antone and Rachelle Boucher were named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Team in 2008.

Perry also stresses the importance of personal development and community service. The team hosted a clinic for teams involved in the Special Olympics Kentucky softball tournament, a Breast Cancer Awareness day and a Big Brothers, Big

Sisters day. The team has also been involved with Habitat For Humanity and other community engagements.

Perry, who came to WKU after leading Birmingham-Southern for six years, led the Panthers to their first-ever winning season, a 28-21 record. Perry recorded 146 wins overall at Birmingham-Southern, including winning at least 25 contests in each of the last five years. Additionally, she posed a 36-39 mark against Big South opponents (the school was not eligible for the league title in 2003 as a provisional NCAA Division I member.)

In all, Perry had 15 players earn postseason honors from the Big South Conference with a high of five following both the 2005 and '06 campaigns.

Perry was inducted into the 2007 Zachary High School Hall of Fame in her hometown of Zachary, Louisiana. In 2006, Perry added the title of Assistant Athletic Director/Senior Women's Administrator to her duties and served as BSC's compliance director. Perry was the head coach for the Southeastern All-Star team that played the United States Olympic squad prior to the 2004 games in Athens.

Perry is a 1997 and 1998 graduate of Louisiana State University, earning her degree in kinesiology in '97 and adding a master's degree in sports administration in '98. In addition, she completed a compliance internship at LSU from 1998-2000 before becoming a head coach.

Perry lettered for the Tigers for two years, in 1997 and '98, helping the school to a combined 102-28 (78.5%) record, a 58-14 (80.6%) mark in the Southeastern Conference play, two Southeastern Conference Western Division titles and the school's first-ever NCAA Regional Tournament appearance where the Tigers finished second.

She was a second-team National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-South Region selection her first season, adding first-team All-Louisiana honors as well as a place on the league's all-tournament team, after leading LSU with a .345 batting average, 11 home runs, 40 runs scored, a .416 on-base percentage and a .612 slugging percentage. Off the field, Perry was named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll twice.

BETH MULLINS
 First Assistant Coach

First Assistant Coach Beth Mullins begins her first season on the hill for the Lady Toppers. Prior to coming to WKU, Mullins was an assistant coach at the University of Alabama at Birmingham the previous three seasons where she worked with hitting and infield development along with recruiting and scouting.

During her three seasons at UAB, the Blazers offense improved tremendously leading to the first NCAA Regional appearance in school history following the 2010 season. UAB hitters broke 15 individual and school offensive records including the school record for batting average, runs, hits, RBIs and triples. UAB finished at the top of Conference USA in six offensive categories and were ranked in the top three in every other major hitting category in the conference.

Mullins served as an assistant coach for two seasons at Georgia Southern (2006-07) prior to joining the UAB staff. She helped the Eagles softball team to the Southern Conference Tournament Championship in 2006 and a runner-up finish in 2007.

Coaching at her alma mater, Mullins was a four-year letterwinner (2001-04) during her collegiate playing career. She earned All Conference USA honors and finished her career tied for first on UAB's all-time home run list. After the 2001 season, Mullins was named to the Conference USA All-Freshman Team after starting 52 of 55 games.



BONNIE BYNUM

 4th Season

Assistant Coach Bonnie Bynum begins her fourth year on the Hill after helping guide the Lady Toppers under Coach Perry the last three seasons.

Bynum, who works with the WKU pitching staff, worked in three new pitchers to the WKU pitching staff last season. Bynum led the pitchers to a total of 212 strikeouts during the 2010 season with Kim Wagner recording 102 strikeouts and a record of 15-10 with a 2.38 ERA.

In 2009 Bynum led Ryan Rogge to a second team All-Sun Belt Conference selection after leading the senior to an overall record of 27-10. Rogge, who finished the season with a 1.66 ERA, gave up just 188 hits, 74 runs and 28 walks while striking out 152 batters. During the conference tournament, she finished with a 3-2 record after pitching five complete games and giving up just ten earned runs in 34.1 innings of work.

Bynum comes from Tennessee Tech, where she lettered all four years for the Golden Eagles on the pitching staff. She finished her career with 103 victories, including a record-setting 34 wins in 2007, and was twice named TTU's Outstanding Female Athlete of the year. During her junior season, the Fayetteville, Ga., native was named OVC Pitcher and Female Athlete of the Year. She earned first-team all-OVC and OVC Tournament Most Valuable Player accolades for three straight years.

Bynum ended her career appearing in 193 games, throwing 1,021 strikeouts and six no-hitters. She finished '07 ranked seventh nationally in victories. During her senior year, she posted a 1.50 earned run average, throwing 33 complete games and 11 shutouts while pitching over 300 innings.

Brooke Reed enters her first season as the volunteer assistant coach for the Lady Toppers making the transition from athlete to coach. Reed finished her senior season as a Lady Topper in 2010. She finished second on the team with a .301 batting average and 24 runs. Reed tallied 10 doubles and two home runs during her final season, with four stolen bases and 66 putouts.

Before coming to WKU Reed played her first two seasons at Birmingham-Southern where she finished second on the team in RBI's with 21 and stolen bases with 11 her sophomore season.

A native of Lake Charles, Louisiana, Reed graduated from LaGrange Senior High in 2005 as a four-year starter for the Gators. She is currently pursuing a master's degree in Recreation and Sports Administration at WKU.

Beth Varvil returns for her third season as athletic trainer for the Lady Topper softball squad in 2010.

Varvil joined the WKU athletic training staff in August of 2007. She earned her Bachelor's degree from Arkansas State University in the spring of 2007.

While she was with the Red Wolves, Varvil completed clinical rotations with the ASU football squad, baseball and women's soccer programs. She served as a graduate assistant on the Hill, working with the volleyball team and swimming and diving squads.
