YOUR NEW SCHOOL IS COMING!

In the tradition of our strong neighborhood schools, in West and Central Houston, the Houston Independent School District is building a new state-of-the-art elementary school in the St. George Place subdivision at 5430 Hidalgo Street.

Scheduled to open in early 2007, the **NEW SCHOOL** will be the zoned school for families living in the St. George Place, Larchmont, and Afton Oaks subdivisions.

The school building will be completed in early 2006. It will then temporarily house students from Briargrove Elementary while their replacement school is under construction.

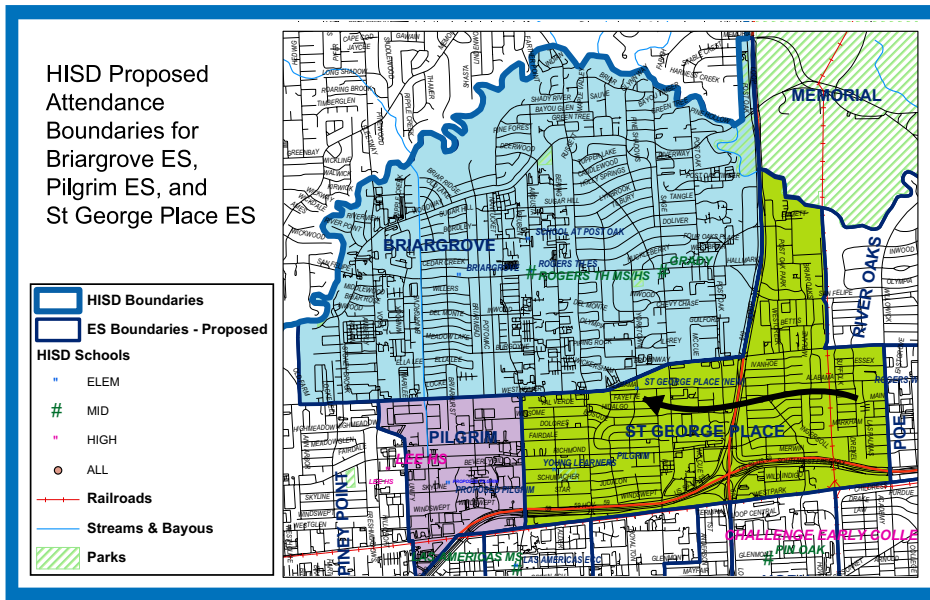
Students who live in the zoned areas who wish to go to school in the new facility while it is temporarily occupied by Briargrove Elementary will be allowed to enroll based on grade level availability. Students zoned to Briargrove will receive priority.

WHAT WILL IT LOOK LIKE?

The \$14-million facility will include 86,000 square feet of space within a traditional-style building. It will house 750 students from prekindergarten through fifth grade.

The educational programs we will offer will reflect the common visions of the communities involved. We will be a community of effort based upon high standards and meeting the needs of all children.

Academic excellence and a genuine love of learning is our top priority! We want parent participation in helping us design the educational programs we will offer at this school.

If you live in one of the zoned neighborhoods (St. George Place, Larchmont, or Afton Oaks) and you have a child of elementary-school age (PK-5), enroll your child at the existing School at Post Oak (1331 Augusta) for the fall 2006 semester.

The School at Post Oak is a TEA Recognized school that was established five years ago to relieve overcrowding in neighboring schools. This overcrowding has resulted in the construction of the new school.

The School at Post Oak offers fabulous teachers, great sports facilities, and the opportunity to make new friends.

All students enrolled in the School at Post Oak (approximately 200) will be moved from the leased space at the Post Oak YMCA into the new school (anticipated date, early 2007).
