la I request duty in Vietnam. My billet preference is "Swift" boats with a second choice of Patrol Officer in a PHE Squadron.

2. Since reporting aboard GRIDLET in June, 1967, I served for 7 months as Electrical Officer and "E" Division Officer and have held the billet of First Ligutement and First Division Officer since December 1967. Prior to joining the Havy I had extensive small boat experience which I believe would serve me well as Officer in Charge of a "Swift" boat. I have attended the following Mavy courses : Prospective Officer of the Deck Emergency Shiphandling, Damage Control School (Stability and NBC), CEC Watch Officer School, and Air-Intercept Controller School.

3. I request to be transferred upon GRIDLET's return from WESTFAC deployment in June. The ship is presently scheduled to be de-commissioned in September 1968 in Bath, Maine for AAW modernisation. I would consider extending my obligated service for duty as OIC of a PCF if necessary. My RAD date is December 1969.
