Guantánamo by the Numbers

The Detainees

- ✓ Total number of detainees ever incarcerated at Guantánamo: 779.1
- ✓ Detainees released under President Bush: over 500.2
- ✓ Detainees at start of Obama Presidency: 242.3
- ✓ Number of 242 detainees approved for release: 126.4
- ✓ Detainees transferred, repatriated or resettled under Obama: 70.5
- ✓ Detainees transferred to US for prosecution: 1.6
- ✓ Detainees who died in custody since January 2009: 3.7
- Detainees currently held at Guantánamo: 169.8
- Remaining detainees approved for release: 87.9
- Detainees convicted by military commission before 2009 and still held at Guantánamo: 110
- Detainees Obama Administration designated for trial or commission including those tried since January 2009: 36.11
- Detainees Obama Administration has designated for indefinite detention without charge or trial: 46.12
- ✓ Yemenis not included in above totals under conditional detention: 30.13
- ✓ Number of countries that have accepted Guantánamo detainees: 51.14

Financial Costs

- ✓ Yearly cost to U.S. taxpayers of a federal prisoner: \$27,251.15
- ✓ Yearly cost to hold each captive at Guantánamo instead of federal prison: \$800,000.16
- Annual cost to operate Guantánamo: \$150 million.¹⁷

Federal Courts & Challenges to Military Commissions

- Federal court convictions since 9/11 on terrorism-related charges: over 400.18
- ✓ Detainees at GTMO convicted by military commission: 7.19
- ☑ Detainees prosecuted in U.S. federal courts: 1 -- Ahmed Ghailani.²⁰
- ☑ Detainees federal courts have determined were being held unlawfully: 38.21
- Detainees who have lost their habeas corpus petitions challenging their detention: 21.22
- ✓ Times military commissions have been re-vamped: 3.23
- ☑ Cases involving detainee rights that have gone before the U.S. Supreme Court: 4.24
- ☑ Times Supreme Court Justices have sided with the detainees: 4.25

Federal Prisons Holding Terrorists

- ☑ Those convicted of terrorism-related charges being held in U.S. prisons: 355.26
- Those convicted of terrorism-related charges who have escaped from any part of the federal prison system:

Deaths in Custody

✓ Detainees who have died at Guantánamo: 8.28

Additional History

- First detainees brought to Guantánamo: January 11, 2002.²⁹
- ☑ Last known arrival: March 14, 2008.30
- ☑ Last known departure: April 19, 2012.31
- ☑ Date military commissions first established, by military order: November 13, 2001.32
- **☑** Bounties paid by Bush Administration to anyone who would hand over a possible terror suspect: \$3,000 to \$25,000.33
