The Escanaba Municipal Marina has boaters dock/storage boxes that may be either rented or purchased from the Harbor Master. The dock boxes are fiberglass with white gel coat cover, of good quality, and are available in various sizes dependent upon the location of your slip. If you are interested in renting or purchasing a dock box, please contact the Harbor Master.

Schooner Inland Seas to Visit Escanaba on July 19-26, 2010

The schooner Inland Seas, also known as "The Great Lakes Schoolship" will visit the Escanaba Municipal Marina on July 19-26th. The Inland Seas Education Association is a non-profit organization whose mission is to help people of all ages experience the science and spirit of the Great Lakes through shipboard and on-shore programs. Inland Seas was launched in 1994 and is based in Suttons Bay. The vessel is 78' in overall length and the beam is 17' wide. The hull of the ship is made from 3/16" thick welded steel. Masts are constructed of aluminum tube and the booms are solid douglas fir. The interior of the ship is bald cypress with mahogany trim. The maximum number of students allowed per visit is 32. A permit application to replace the failing portion of the L-Dock walkway was filed with the US Army Corps of Engineers/MDEQ on April 29, 2010. Once the permit is approved, construction bids will be solicited with construction planned for the fall of 2010.

Pavilion, Band Shell and Gazebo Reservations

The City of Escanaba Recreation Department is now accepting reservations for the pavilion, band shell, gazebo, and other park facilities for 2011. The pavilion has 10 eight-person picnic tables, electric service, and potable water. The band shell is a multi-use facility for concerts, plays, religious functions, wedding ceremonies, and more. The pavilion and band shell have a \$50 per day use fee.
