DAILY NEWSPAPERS CIRCULATION REPORT 2009

The 2009 Circulation Data Report calculates paid circulation levels based on ABC, CCAB or owner-provided data. CCAB currently provides paid averages based on a 12-month period ending December 31st. For those dailies measured by ABC, the paid averages of two six-month ABC Fas Fax reports were utilized for the periods ending March 31st and September 30th. (Prior to 2008, ABC and CCAB circulation data only reflected the 6-month periods ending March 31st.)

The following two methods of analysis were used:

- The average number of copies <u>sold</u> per publishing day (traditional method) and
- The total number of copies <u>sold</u> *per week* or customer cycle (neo-traditional method).

DAILY NEWSPAPERS CIRCULATION REPORT, 2009

2009 TOTAL PAID Circulation Data

Canada's daily **paid** circulation stood at 4.1 million copies on an average publishing day in 2009, and 26.9 million copies in an average week. There were 96 English and French paid-for dailies in Canada last year, two less than in 2008 and three less than in 2007.

The English language independent in Flin Flon, Manitoba, The Reminder, ceased publishing as a daily, but still publishes three days a week. Three dailies in Ontario (The Recorder and Times in Brockville, The Chatham Daily News and The Daily Observer in Pembroke) reduced their six-day publishing cycle to five days –Tuesday to Saturday. The Daily Graphic in Portage La Prairie, Manitoba, reduced its distribution from five days to four days –Tuesday to Friday.

Papers audited by CCAB now provide 12-month averages ending December 31st. For those dailies audited by ABC, data from two 6-months Fas Fax reports, ending March 31st and September 30th, has been averaged to provide a 12-month picture.

Not covered in the body of this report, but included as an addendum, are the 18 free daily newspapers currently distributed in Canada. This relatively new breed of free dailies came to Canada in 2000 and continues to successfully capture new, young readers. Six ownership groups publish most of these papers totaling almost 1.6 million copies daily. Torstar and Metro International SA jointly publish 'Metro' in Toronto, Ottawa, Edmonton, Calgary and Vancouver. Transcontinental publishes Montreal's Métro together with Metro International SA. Quebecor publishes 24 Hours in Toronto, Ottawa, Edmonton, Calgary and Vancouver, in addition to 24 Heures in Ottawa-Gatineau and Montreal.

Canwest's free dailies, Ottawa Rush Hour, Edmonton Rush Hour and Calgary Rush Hour have folded, in addition to its national free daily, Dose. The free papers published by Black Press in British Columbia are distributed two to three times a week and do not qualify as dailies.

CIRCULATION BY REGION

The 11 Quebec dailies remained relatively stable in 2009, down by a marginal -0.3% compared to 2008. Quebec's share of the paid daily or weekly circulation pie grew by almost +1%.

Ontario's portion of the total newspaper market stands at 42%, heavily influencing Canada's overall circulation trends. Ontario continued to suffer the most losses in 2009, down by -7.5% in 2009 in an average day, but the decline was considerably less than the -12.5% decline registered in 2008. The number of paid-for dailies in Ontario dropped by one in 2009, to 38. Two dailies, the Cobourg Star and the Port Hope Evening Guide, in addition to the weekly Colborne Chronicle, were combined to create Northumberland Today.

There were 17 dailies in the Prairie provinces in 2009, one less than in 2008. The Reminder, the independently owned paper in Flin Flon, Manitoba, converted to a weekly by reducing its publishing cycle from five days to three. The Prairies registered average paid losses of -3.4%, just under the national average of -4.1%.

The 13 papers in the Atlantic provinces recorded paid circulation declines of -2.2% on an average day, only half of the national circulation losses.

The 17 dailies in the B.C./Yukon region registered an average daily decline of -1.8% in 2009 after posting the sole increase (+3.4%) in 2008. The dailies in this region comprise 11.8% of the total daily circulation in Canada, up slightly from an 11.5% share in the previous year.

CIRCULATION BY LANGUAGE

There were 85 English language paid dailies in 2009, two less than in 2008. Total paid circulation stood at 3.3 million on an average day and 21.4 million in an average week. Circulation levels dipped by -4.8%, about half of the losses experienced in 2008. The English papers comprise 80% of the total circulation in Canada.

The 11 French language paid dailies, which account almost 12% of the total *number* of papers, continue to deliver an impressive 20% of the total daily and weekly circulation levels. The French dailies posted a marginal decline of -1.9%, less than half of the losses experienced by the English-language dailies.

CIRCULATION BY FORMAT

The broadsheet dailies, which comprise over three-quarters of the total circulated daily and weekly copies, dipped by -3.5% in 2009, cutting the losses experienced in 2008 in half.

The tabloid-dailies, which account for 18% of the total number of daily newspapers, represent about one-quarter of the total weekly paid circulation in Canada. The tabloid dailies declined by about -6.2% in 2009, significantly less than the loss recognized in 2008 (-11.5%).

There are currently 80 broadsheet and 16 tabloid dailies in Canada, one less of each format, than in 2008.

CIRCULATION IN COMPETITIVE MARKETS

A competitive market, in this report, is one in which two or more daily newspapers are published. While competition exists in other markets through spill from newspapers from outside the market, these figures are not available using the ABC or CCAB reports. There are currently nine competitive daily newspaper markets in Canada, the same as in 2008 and one less than in 2007.

Montreal was the only competitive market to post increases in 2009, rising by +0.3% in an average week and day. Three dailies, The Gazette (+8.2%), Le Devoir (+1.7%) and La Presse (+0.1%) registered circulation growth over 2008.

The highly competitive Toronto market, supporting four English language paid dailies, declined the most in 2009, posting a -9.9% loss on an average day and -9.8% in an average week. The Toronto papers represent over one-fifth of Canada's total daily paid circulation, greatly impacting overall national circulation levels.

Edmonton also posted paid circulation losses greater than the national average, down by -4.7% on an average day or week.

Dailies in four competitive markets, Vancouver, Sherbrooke, Calgary and Quebec, remained relatively stable in 2009, recording decreases of less than 2% over 2008.

NEWSPAPER OWNERSHIP OVERVIEW

There are currently 13 daily newspaper ownership groups in Canada in addition to three independent daily newspapers, one less than in 2008. Canwest's dailies continue to have the most circulation, delivering an average of almost 8.2 million paid copies weekly, 1.3 million on an average day, and a 31% share of the total Canadian daily newspaper market.

Quebecor owns the most number of dailies (36) and is the second largest owner in terms of total paid circulation, with 6.4 million in an average week and almost 1 million in an average day. The number of Quebecor dailies reduced by one last year, when the Cobourg Star and Port Hope Evening Guide were replaced by Northumberland Today.

F.P. Canadian Newspapers Limited Partnership, posted an increase in 2009, with its two dailies selling one percent more copies in an average week over 2008.

TECHNICAL NOTES

Definition of "Daily Newspaper": A daily newspaper for the purposes of this report is a paid publication containing general news, published four or more times per week in either of Canada's official languages.

Sources of Data: The data used in this report is based on the CCAB and ABC reports. For CCAB, 12-month audit period ending December 31st, 2009 was used. For ABC, two 6-month Fas Fax reports, ending March 31st and September 2009, were averaged to reflect a comparable 12-month period.

Calculation of Circulation Data: Circulation data as published by ABC and CCAB is quite adequate to describe the circulation of an individual daily. However, in order to establish meaningful industry-wide data, it is necessary to make further calculations based on these figures.

This necessity is based on the fact that there is no single publication schedule that applies across the industry. Some newspapers publish five days a week; some six; some seven. Some dailies publish on Saturday, but do not publish on Sunday, and others, vice versa. Two dailies do not publish on Monday. For some newspapers, the Friday edition has the highest circulation of the week; for many newspapers Saturday is the strongest; and others have a peak in circulation on Sunday.

Two methods of calculating circulation data are used in this report. Each has its advocates. Since they are calculated using the same basic information, they have been names "Traditional" and "Neo-Traditional".

Traditional Method. This method takes the sum of the copies <u>sold</u> by each newspaper in one week, and then divides that sum by the number of days that the newspaper publishes in that week. These averages are then totaled for all Canadian dailies. The result is the *average number of copies sold per publishing day*.

Neo-Traditional Method. This method takes the sum of the copies <u>sold</u> by each newspaper in one week, and then simply totals these sums for all Canadian dailies. The result is the *total* number of copies sold per week (or per consumer purchase cycle).
