Education & Music Library guide to resources

To locate resources for Canadian music consult *The Catalogue* (http://sundog.usask.ca). The catalogue identifies relevant publications in all branches of the University of Saskatchewan Library, as well as providing access to a growing collection of electronic resources.

Subject headings may also be subdivided by province or region, e.g. **Popular music – Saskatchewan** or **Music – Atlantic Provinces**.

Most music resources will be found in the Education & Music Library stacks in the Library of Congress call number ranges beginning with M (scores/recordings), ML (literature) and MT (instruction and study). A more detailed outline of the LC Classification for music is available in print and online (https://library.usask.ca/files/education/music_classification.pdf).

Resources directly supporting the K-12 school music curriculum are catalogued in the Dewey Decimal system. They can be found in the 372.87-372.873 and 780-789 ranges of the Education & Music Library's Curriculum Collection. Earlier materials that were once authorized for use in Saskatchewan schools can be found in the same call number ranges in the library's Historical Textbook Collection.

B. FINDING JOURNAL ARTICLES

The Library catalogue allows you to identify journals that may be relevant to your research, but it does not provide information about individual journal articles. We use a variety of databases to provide this level of access. These databases index and provide summaries of journal contents. Many of them also link to full text electronic versions of the journals indexed. Selected databases which will help you to find journal articles include:

Canadian Music Periodical Index (CMPI)

CMPI is an open access database provided by the Library and Archives Canada, covering 630 Canadian music journals, newsletters and magazines dating from the late-19th century to the present.

CBCA Education

An index to Canadian periodicals in the field of education, including Music education. Coverage varies by publication, with *The Canadian Music Educator* indexed from 1992 to the present. May be cross-searched with other CBCA databases, or with the international *ProQuest Education Journals* database.
