LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND**The Colchester (Parish) Order 2004**Made - - - 18th March 2004*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect (without modifications) to a recommendation made to him by Colchester Borough Council, following a review conducted by them in accordance with Part II of that Act, for the alteration of the area of a parish within the borough of Colchester:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Colchester (Parish) Order 2004.

(2) It shall come into force —

- (a) for the purposes of this article and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2004, on the day after that on which it is made;
- (b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2004.

(3) In this Order “the map” means the map prepared by the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister, marked “Map referred to in the Colchester (Parish) Order 2004” and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b).

Alteration of parish area

2.—The area of the parish ward of Cherry Tree which is shaded in green and designated by the letter “A” on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of East Donyland.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect (without modifications) to recommendations sent to the Secretary of State for the alteration of the area of a parish within the borough of Colchester following a district review. As a consequence of this Order, the area of the parish ward of Cherry Tree, shall cease to be part of the parish of East Donyland. The Order does not move this area to form part of any other parish and the area accordingly ceases to fall within any parish.

A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the area concerned. 1st April 2004 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make general provision in relation to orders such as this Order.
