The North Hertfordshire (Parish) Order 2004

Made

- 2nd December 2004

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, which gives effect (without modification) to a petition sent to him under section 11 of that Act, for the constitution as a parish within the district of North Hertfordshire of an area of which no part is within a parish, and for the establishment of a parish council for that area:

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the North Hertfordshire (Parish) Order 2004.
- (2) It shall come into force
  - (a) for the purposes of this article and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2005, on the day after that on which it is made;
  - (b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2005.
- (3) In this Order -

"the new parish" means the parish constituted by article 2; and

"the map" means the map prepared by the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister, marked "Map of the North Hertfordshire (Parish) Order 2004" and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b).

#### Constitution of a new parish

- 2.—(1) A new parish, comprising the area outlined with a blue line on the map, shall be constituted within the district of North Hertfordshire.
  - (2) The name of the new parish shall be Letchworth Garden City.

#### Directions to establish a parish council

3. — The North Hertfordshire District Council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the new parish.

#### **Transitional Provision**

4. — Until the councillors elected to the council of the parish of Letchworth Garden City at the elections to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2005 come into office, the parish of Letchworth Garden City shall be represented by those persons who, immediately before the coming into force of this Order, are the elected councillors for the district wards of Letchworth East, Letchworth South East, Letchworth South West, Wilbury and Grange.

#### **Order Date**

5. — 1st April 2005 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect (without modifications) to a petition sent to the Secretary of State for the creation as a parish of an area within the district of North Hertfordshire and for the establishment of a parish council for that area. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the area concerned.


Article 2 creates the parish to be called Letchworth Garden City.

Article 3 directs the North Hertfordshire District Council to establish a parish council for the new parish.

Article 4 provides for the parish of Letchworth Garden City to be represented by the district councillors elected for the district wards of Letchworth East, Letchworth South East, Letchworth South West, Wilbury and Grange until councillors for the new parish, to be elected on the ordinary day of elections in 2005, come into office.

Article 5 specifies the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2005 as the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make provision of general application in relation to orders such as this Order.
