



Honeycomb Baby Blanket

LT2150



Designed by Glenda Winkleman.

Throw measures 37" x 37".

TLC® "Baby": 4 skeins 5964 Napttime **A**; 1 skein each 5011 White **B**, 5737 Powder Pink **C**, and 5881 Powder Blue **D**.

Afghan Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].

Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 17 sts = 4"; 15 rows = 4" in pattern with afghan hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Special Abbreviation

fpdc (front post double crochet) = yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front around the post of indicated stitch and draw yarn through, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.

BLANKET

With **A** and afghan hook, ch 139.

Row 1: Keeping all loops on hook, draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 139 loops on hook; do NOT turn; work loops off as follows: yo and draw through 1 loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops] 138 times – 1 loop remains on hook.

Row 2: * With yarn at back of work, draw up a loop in next vertical bar, with yarn at front of work, draw up a loop in next vertical bar; repeat from * to last 2 vertical bars; [with yarn at back of work, draw up a loop in next vertical bar] twice – 139 loops on hook; do NOT turn; yo and draw through 1 loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops] 138 times.

Row 3: * With yarn at front of work, draw up a loop in next vertical bar, with yarn at back of work, draw up a loop in next vertical bar; repeat from * across; do NOT turn; yo and draw through 1 loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops] 138 times.

Rows 4-123: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for pattern 60 times.

Row 124: Repeat Row 2.

Row 125: * With yarn at front of work, insert hook from front to back between both vertical strands of next st, draw a loop through the fabric and through the loop on the hook, with yarn in back of work, insert hook from front to back between both vertical strands of next st, draw a loop through the fabric and through the loop on hook; repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Border

Round 1: With right side facing and crochet hook, attach **B** in upper right corner; ch 3, * dc in each st across to next corner, ch 2, dc in each row-end to next corner, ch 2; repeat from * once more; join with a slip st in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

Round 2: Join **C** in any ch-2 space; ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in same space, * fpdc around each dc to next corner **, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in corner ch-2 space; repeat from * around, end at **; join. Fasten off.



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Round 3: Join **D** in any ch-2 space; ch 5, dc in same space, * fpdc in each fpdc and each dc to next corner **, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in corner ch-2 space; repeat from * around, end at *; join in 3rd ch of ch-5. Fasten off.

Round 4: With **B**, repeat Rnd 3.

Round 5: With **C**, repeat Rnd 3.

Round 6: Join **D** in any ch-2 space; ch 3, 5 dc in same space, * fpdc in each fpdc and each dc to next corner **, 6 dc in corner ch-2 space; repeat from * around, end at **; join. Fasten off.

Round 7: Join **A** in any st; ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next st, ch 3, slip st in last sc made, * sc in next 2 sts, ch 3, slip st in last sc made; repeat from * around; join in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
