

Instructions to Voter:

To vote for your choice in each contest, turn the SELECT wheel to highlight your choice and then press ENTER to mark your choice. After marking all desired choices, carefully review the Ballot Summary Page. Only after you have reviewed your choices, press CAST BALLOT to complete the voting process. You have finished voting when you see the waving American flag.

To vote for a Write-In Candidate, turn the SELECT wheel to highlight the "Write-In" choice and then press ENTER. Turn the SELECT wheel and press ENTER to spell out the name of the candidate you wish to write-in. Turn the SELECT wheel to highlight "Accept" and press ENTER.

QUESTION 1**

Question 1:

Shall Section 1.02 of the Knox County Charter be amended to reserve powers to the Board of Education and elected Charter and Constitutional Officers by deleting the period (".") at the end of the first sentence and substituting therefore a comma (",") and adding at the end of the sentence the phrase "Board of Education, and elected Charter and Constitutional Officers as defined by the Constitution of the State of Tennessee."?

Question 2:

Shall Section 2.02.1 of the Knox County Charter be amended to enable the County Commission to appoint members to those boards and commissions deemed necessary by deleting the first sentence in said section in its entirety and substituting therefore the following sentence: "By resolution, the Commission may appoint members to those boards and commissions the County Commission deems necessary in the furtherance of its duties and responsibilities under this Charter or as provided by state law."?

QUESTION 3**

Question 3:

Shall Section 2.02.A of the Knox County Charter be amended to reserve powers to the Board of Education and elected Charter and Constitutional Officers by deleting the second sentence in its entirety and substituting therefore the following sentence: "However, neither the Commission nor the Chair of the Commission shall exercise any powers or perform any functions of the County Government which are vested, by the terms of this Charter, in the Executive Branch, Judicial Branch, Board of Education, and elected Charter and Constitutional Officers as defined by the Constitution of the State of Tennessee."?

QUESTION 4**

Question 4:

Shall Section 2.03.C of the Knox County Charter be amended to waive the district residency requirement for eligibility for election to the Knox County Commission for the first year after redistricting by deleting the first sentence in its entirety and substituting therefore the following sentence: "No person shall be eligible to serve as a member of the Commission unless that person shall have attained the age of eighteen (18) and is a resident of, and a registered voter in, the district from which such person seeks election on the date he/she filed his/her nominating petition and has been a resident of both the County and the district for one (1) year prior to such person's election; provided, however, that the district residency requirement shall not apply in the first year after redistricting for the general election at which Commission seats appear on the ballot."?

COUNTY CHARTER AMENDMENT QUESTION 5

Question 5:

Shall Section 6.01.E of the Knox County Charter be amended to waive the district residency requirement for eligibility for election to the Knox County Board of Education for the first year after redistricting by deleting the first sentence in its entirety and substituting therefore the following sentence: "No person shall be eligible to serve as a member of the Board of Education unless that person shall have attained the age of eighteen (18) and is a resident of, and a registered voter in, the district from which such person seeks election on the date he/she filed his/her nominating petition and has been a resident of both the County and the district for one (1) year prior to such person's election; provided, however, that the district residency requirement shall not apply in the first year after redistricting for the general election at which a seat on the Board of Education appears on the ballot."?

COUNTY CHARTER AMENDMENT QUESTION 6

Question 6:

Shall Section 9.03.I of the Knox County Charter be amended to define two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Commission by deleting said section in its entirety and substituting therefore the following language: "The phrase "two-thirds (2/3) of the members (or membership) of the Commission" shall mean at least two-thirds (2/3) of the membership of the Commission as provided in Section 2.03.A. of this Charter. Any fraction of a number that results in calculating two-thirds (2/3) of the members (or membership) of the Commission shall be rounded up."?

Question 7:

Shall Section 2.02.B of the Knox County Charter be amended to enable the certified public accountant or firm of certified public accountants performing the annual independent audit of accounts to be employed for no more than eight (8) years by deleting the phrase "four (4) successive years" in the last sentence and substituting therefore the following language: "eight (8) consecutive years with an initial four (4) year term. At the end of the four (4) year term, Commission shall issue a Request for Proposals for the next four (4) year period."?
