How to Book Tickets

The City Ground Ticket Office

Buying tickets with Nottingham Forest couldn't be easier. Our friendly staff are on hand to help with all your ticket enquiries. Simply walk up to the counter and ask for assistance. You will be asked for your client reference number this can be found on your ticket. Make sure you keep hold of this as it is unique to you.

Over the phone

If you are unable to visit us at the Ticket Office, you can call us on 0871 226 1980* and book tickets over the phone. You can then arrange collection or delivery - whichever suits you best. We also have a matchday Saturday booking line, which is available from 9am - 12 noon for 3pm kick-offs.

Where to go All You Need To Know About Your Tickets

Now you have purchased your tickets you will need to know where to sit and how to get into the ground. If you have purchased your tickets online and have not had them posted they will be available for collection from the ticket collection window. The ticket collection window is next to the Main Reception entrance at The Main Stand. Make sure you bring your booking confirmation e-mail containing your booking reference number with you on the day.

Once you have collected your tickets, make your way to the stand and turnstile indicated on your ticket.

We have included a map of the blocks and stands below so you know where to go. However, if you are unsure on the day please approach our stewards who will be more than happy to assist you.

All you need to do now is take your seat and enjoy the match.



Transport

Getting to The City Ground

Nottingham Forest has compiled a comprehensive guide on how to get to The City Ground to make sure you don't have any problems getting here on matchday. Parking isn't available at the ground however there is a range of parking areas in close proximity. For full information on how to get to The City Ground, please visit the travel and parking section on the Official Website.

IV car

If you are travelling to the ground on matchdays, the route is well signposted as 'football and cricket traffic' from all directions. Once you are in the vicinity of the ground please follow temporary matchday signs to local car parks. There is no parking at the stadium itself as priority is given to disabled supporters, coaches, players, match and Club officials.

IV rail

The train station is roughly a 20 minute walk or 10 minute bus ride from The City Ground. The following online rail journey planners might help you to plan your journey:

IV foot/bike

The City Ground is roughly a 20 minute walk from West Bridgford, The Meadows and Nottingham Railway Station, while Gamston and Wilford Hill and the City Centre are roughly 30 minutes on foot. Supporters cycling to the ground can securely park their bikes at three new cycle shelters situated around the ground. To use them you will need to bring your own bike lock.

1V bus
