THE FIELD MUSEUM (*Chicago, IL*) A new exhibit called Whales: Giants of the Deep opens on May 20. Listen to the whales' haunting songs, see massive skeletons, explore a life-size replica of a blue whale's heart, and touch a whale's tooth! Fieldmuseum.org

GEORGIA AQUARIUM (*Atlanta, GA*) Two new juvenile beluga whales (named Grayson and Qinu) have just arrived at the Cold Water Quest exhibit! Unlike adults, who are white, these young'uns are still gray in color. Georgiqaquarium.org

THE WHALE MUSEUM (*San Juan Island, WA*) Dedicated to the mighty killer whale (the Orca) and the ecosystem in nearby waters of the museum. If you're lucky, you just might see some orcas off the coast after your visit! Whalemuseum.org
