255930	No. 4 Sqdn, Australian Flying Corps.	Capt.	Captain ROY KING, DPO.	<p>Between the 30th Oct. and 4th Novr., this Officer destroyed 4 E.A. in the TURNAI-LEUZE-AMN area. He was awarded the D.F.C. on 9th September, 1918, up to which time he had destroyed 9 E.A.</p> <p>The G.O.C., 10th brigade, under whose command he was serving, writes that Captain KING proved himself a very brilliant patrol leader. He set a magnificent example at all times to all pilots in the Squadron by his keenness on the ground and gallantry in the air which was of the highest possible order.</p> <p>Since then Captain KING has brought his record up to 13 E.A. and 4 balloons destroyed. 1 further E.A. destroyed in combined combat. In addition he has taken part in many indecisive combats - he has also done a great amount of valuable and gallant work low flying over the enemy's lines, dropping bombs and shooting up billets and troops with machine gun fire.</p> <p>He has been twice recommended for the D.F.C.</p> <p>It appears that through some mistake probably due to transfer from one brigade to another, followed by the advance into GERMANY, this officer's claims were overlooked.</p>	<p><i>Wm.
