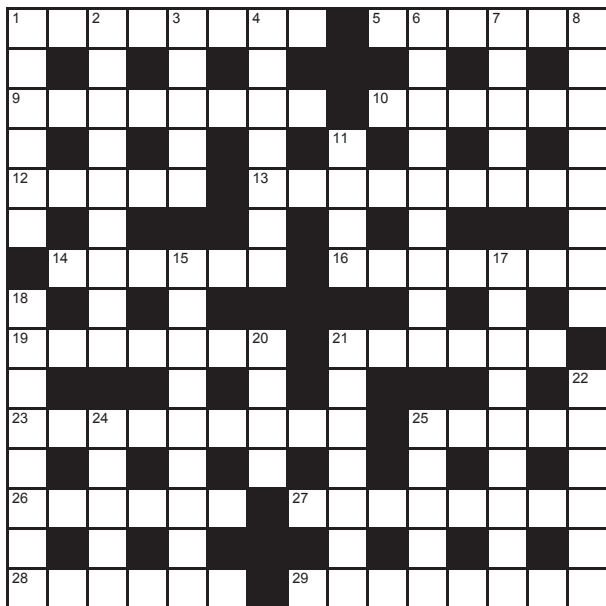


Crossword 14,122 Set by Bradman

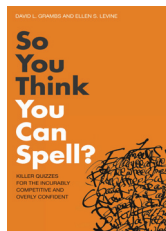
