Settled in Westport, and worked in the Bank of New South Wales before enlisting for service in WW1. Left New Zealand as a corporal in the Otago Mounted Rifles later transferring to the Pioneer Corps of the Canterbury Infantry Regiment.

Killed in action during the Battle of the Somme.
