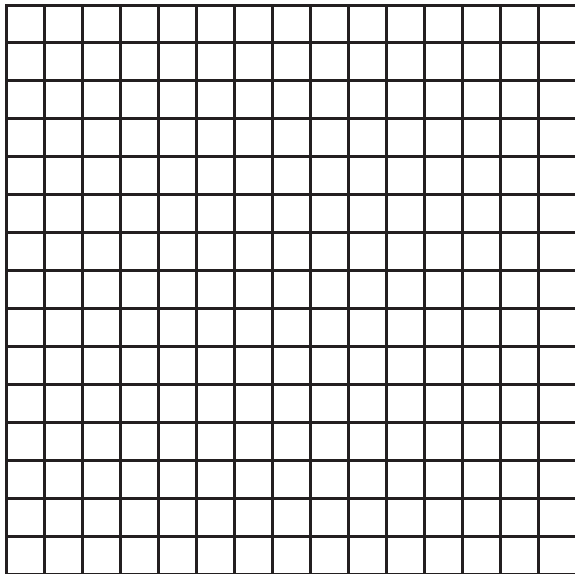


# MONDAY PRIZE CROSSWORD

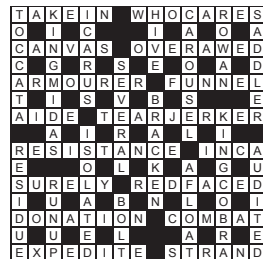
