HANDWORK FOR YOUR WHOLE LIFE

Birthday Crown

Directions

MATERIALS:

- 1) Size G crochet hook
- 2) Yarn: Approximately 2 oz of Peace Fleece Kruschev Corn or your choice of color, worsted weight yarn
- 3) Yarn needle

Headband:

- Start: Chain 49
- Row 1: sc in second chain from hook and across row, turn (48 sts)
- Row 2: sc in each stitch, turn
- Row 3: sc across row, add 30 chains at end of row to add one tie, turn
- Row 4: sc across row to end, add 30 chains at end of row for other tie, turn
- Row 5: sc across 29 sts to finish tie – finish off

Triangles for Crown Points:

- (Make 6)
- Start: Chain 2
- Row 1: 2 sc in second chain from hook, turn
- Row 2: sc across (2 sts), turn
- Row 3: 2 sc in first st, 2 sc in last st (4 st total), turn
- Row 4: sc across (4 sts), turn
- Row 5: 2 sc in first st, sc in next two sts, 2 sc in last st (6 sts total), turn
- Row 6: sc across (6 sts), turn
- Row 7: 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st (8 sts total), turn
- Row 8: sc across (8 sts)
- Finish

Attach triangles to headband:

Single crochet the base of each triangle to headband. All six triangles will fit exactly across band using all 48 stitches.

Abbreviations:

- st = stitch
- sts = stitches
- sc = single crochet



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Crocheted with wool/mohair yarn from Peace Fleece this crown is simple and fun to make even for the beginner!

Fits all ages.



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
