



Horse Reins

This is a simple crochet pattern for the beginner and also makes a good children's project.

Materials

Size G hook

Worsted Weight Yarn (I used yarn from Harrisville Yarns of New Hampshire) in 2 complementary colors

For main chest piece

Chain 31 stitches

Row 1: SC in second chain from hook and across row

Rows 2 – 15: Repeat row 1

Row 16: SC decrease in first two stitches, single crochet across, SC decrease last two stitches

Row 17: SC

Row 18: Repeat row 16

Row 19: SC

Row 20: Repeat row 16

For over the head

Chain 50 stitches (this will form the loop that will go over the child's head). Attach last chain to other side of top chest piece and then single crochet back across. Finish off.

For the reins

On bottom corner of chest piece attach yarn and chain for 54". Attach other end to opposite bottom corner and then single crochet back over chain. Finish off.

In contrast color, single crochet around chest piece for a finished look. For fun, embroider or needle felt a design on the front.
