
- Maemo 5, the 4th step in the evolution towards a mainstream operating system

Things we learn from Nokia N900 for future MeeGo devices


Browser usage on same level than phone and messaging in UK


Number of Application Launches



They were invited from continuous Smartphone360 panel with Symbian devices allowing us also to compare usage changes when moving to Nokia N900.






Platforms based multiple hardware architecture
