-Requests must be made at least 7 days before camp. Late additions will be placed if space available, but not guaranteeing age similarity

»»MEALS FOR COMMUTERS

-Lunch and/or Dinner included for ONE-DAY camps as indicated
-During all other camps commuters will have the opportunity to purchase lunches and dinners for \$10 per meal at registration.

»»PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICIES

-A nonrefundable deposit of \$50 per camper per camp must accompany the application form. The balance is payable prior to or at check in
-Refund requests must be received 2 weeks prior to each camp and can only be handled through the Florida State volleyball camp office, not through Seminoles.com
