Facts & Figures

KEY FACTS

- Sunday's game will be the first time these two sides have met in the IRB Pacific Nations Cup.
- Japan have only once failed to score a try in this fixture.
 This was back in 1991 when they lost 20-9. The USA have also only once failed to score a try in the previous meetings between the two. This was back in 1986 when the sides drew 9-9.
- Sunday's match will be the seventh time the two sides have met at the Prince Chichibu Memorial Stadium, Tokyo. There have been three victories apiece between the two nations at the venue; the last time they met here was in 2011 when Japan won 20-14.
- TODD CLEVER wins his 50th cap for the USA this weekend. CLEVER made his Test debut in a 42-8 loss to Argentina in 2003.
- AYUMU GOROMARU needs 10 more points to reach a total of 300 scored in his Test career.
- Japan need to score one more try to reach 1,000 tries scored in Test history.

UNDER THE MICROSCOPE

- Japan have scored a try in each of their last 20 games. You have to go back to a game against Fiji in Tokyo in 2008
 (Japan lost 24-12) when they last failed to score a try. This run of games included Tests against the All Blacks and France. In comparison, the USA have failed to cross the line on three occasions in their last 20 matches. All three of those games came in their last four matches which were losses to Canada (16-9), Ireland (15-12) and Tonga (18-9).
- Japan have won three of their last five at Prince Chichibu Memorial Stadium. This includes their victory last weekend against Wales which finished 23-8. The USA have played at Sunday's venue on two previous occasions. They came out victorious on both occasions, winning 28-22 win against Romania in 2005, a result that followed up a 41-11 victory over Russia in 2004.
- The Americans could reach 80 tries scored against Japan if they cross the line three times on Sunday. Japan could reach 50 tries scored against the USA if they score two.

TEAM NEWS

- CHRIS WYLES makes his 30th start at fullback to extend his record as most capped starting full back for the USA.
- Japan name the same match day 23 as the one that beat Wales 23-8 last weekend.

MAN IN THE MIDDLE

 GREG GARNER of England will referee the match between Japan and the USA on Sunday and will make his ninth appearance as a Test referee, three days before his 33rd birthday.

HEAD TO HEAD

- Sunday's match between Japan and the USA will be the 20th time these two sides have met but only the first time in this competition. The USA dominate in terms of victories with a total of 12 compared to Japan's six, with one 9-9 draw in 1986.
- Japan have won on the last three occasions the two teams have met, with the USA winning the three previous to that. The last match between the two sides was back in 2011 at the venue for Sunday's match. Japan came out on top winning 20-14.
- If Japan beat the USA on Sunday it will be their fourth win in a row over the USA.
- The first meeting between the two sides was in 1985 when the USA came out victors by a single point, winning 16-15 at the Prince Chichibu Memorial Stadium.
- Japans largest margin of victory against the USA was in 1999 in Honolulu when they won 47-31. The Americans' biggest winning margin over Sunday's opposition was in 1996 when they won 74-5 in San Francisco.
- Both sides are evenly matched in terms of pack size on Sunday. No side have any particular weight advantage up front, with both weighing in at an average 108kg per man.

FORM GUIDE

- The USA have lost their last four games. This run started with a defeat to rivals Canada (16-9) at the end of May. The last time they lost five in a row was between 2007 and 2008 when they found themselves in a losing run of 10 consecutive matches.
- Japan have won their last two games. These included a 16-13 victory over the Canadians on Wednesday and that famous 23-8 win over Wales last Saturday. Before these games, they had gone three matches without a win.

ARE YOU EXPERIENCED?

- Both teams field similar experienced starting XV's, with Japan naming a side with a total of 327 caps compared to the USA's total of 303 caps.
- YOSHIKAZU FUJITA will be the youngest man on the field if he comes off the bench for Japan at the age of 19
- Japan's HITOSHI ONO will be the oldest man on the field at kick off at the age of 35.


