The Giants Ridge Golf Shops offer a variety of golf apparel, gear and accessories for men and women.

Mountain Biking

Mountain bikers can enjoy more than 60 kilometers of trails consisting of single track, cross country ski trails, snowmobile trails and abandoned logging roads that make up some of the best riding in the area – and it's all at Giants Ridge! The best time to mountain bike at Giants Ridge is May through October. Mountain bike rentals are available on-site at the Giants Ridge Rental and Bike Shop.

Giants Ridge Hiking Trails

Early summer to late fall, enjoy the beautiful scenery here on the Laurentian Divide! Giants Ridge offers three new signed hiking trails, easy to moderate. Two trails, the Cedar/Alpine and the Sleeping Giant, utilize part of the Alpine, as well as the cross-country area, and offer breathtaking views from the top of Giants Ridge. The Silver/Laurentian trail covers the rolling, forested terrain to the North of The Legend golf course, with very easy to hike trails, and beautiful fall colors. Guided hikes are available on weekday mornings for a minimal cost, and can be arranged through the Ridge Roost Gift Shop at 218-865-3003.

Giants Ridge Alpine Skiing

Giants Ridge is the state's Number One Ski Resort (Minnesota's Number One Ski Area & One of the Top Five in the Midwest, *SKI* magazine) and among the top three resorts in the Midwest. Thirty-four alpine runs ranging from easy to advanced, terrain park and half pipe. Located adjacent to Giants Ridge Ski Chalet.

Vertical Drop: 500 feet

Lifts: Two-triple chairlifts, three double chairlifts, a J-bar and a Magic Carpet give Giants Ridge the uphill capacity of 7,800 skiers per hour. The lift lengths run between 1,800 and 2,500 feet.



Cross Country Skiing

Sixty kilometers of cross country trails climb on and over Giants Ridge which straddles the Laurentian Divide with superb overlooks of the scenic Embarrass River, Wynne Lake and Sabin Lake.

Trails: Sixty kilometers of trails, some designed to challenge the most serious skier and others to be enjoyed by recreational skiers. Lift access to three recreation trails (16km) and the downhill portions of several advanced trails. Lighted skiing on three kilometers for night skiing on designated days.

Giants Ridge Chalet

The Giants Ridge Chalet is located at the base of the ski area. The cafeteria and Pine Cone Bar & Grill are open during ski area operations. Full-service banquet, meeting, conference and wedding facilities available year-round.
