

Application for a Code Modification of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code

Section 106.3 of the Uniform Statewide Building Code states in part, "Upon application by the owner or the owner's agent, the building official may approve a modification of any provision of the USBC, provided the spirit and functional intent of the code are observed and public health, welfare and safety are assured."

Section 106.3.1 Supporting data. "The building official may require or may consider a statement from an RDP or other person competent in the subject area of the application as to the equivalency of the proposed modification. In addition, the building official may require the application to include construction documents sealed by an RDP."
