

## Existing Plan

## Renaming Plan





Currently, O'Hare has two east-west runways. New parallel runways, both north and south of the existing runways, will be constructed over the next few years. By the end of 2011, the Airport will have four parallel east-west runways, two on the north side of the main terminal core area and two on the south. The two north side runways will be named 9L-27R and 9R-27L, and the south side runways will be named 10L-28R and 10R-28L. In order to accommodate pilots as they adjust to the visual development of the future north runway, the FAA and the City of Chicago have agreed to make the following runway name changes as part of a phased re-designation program:

- July 5, 2007 Existing 9R-27L will be renamed 10-28.
- August 30, 2007 Existing 9L-27R will be renamed 9R-27L.
- November 2008 New north runway will become 9L-27R.
