



Crocheted Candy Corn Ghostie

Design by Michele Wilcox

Skill Level



Ghost measures approximately 14" tall.

Materials:

Yarn: Deborah Norville *Everyday Soft Worsted™ Solids* by Premier® Yarns (100% Pill-Resistant Acrylic; 4 ounces; 203 yards)

- ED100-01 Snow White (A) – 1 ball
- ED100-12 Black (B) – 1 ball
- ED100-22 Bittersweet (C) – 1 ball
- ED100-03 Baby Yellow (D) – 1 ball

Crochet hook: US G-6 (4mm)

Extras: Yarn needle; polyester fiberfill

Gauge: 4 sc and 4 rnds = 1" in sc. *Use any size hook necessary to obtain the specified gauge.*

Special Abbreviation

Sc2tog (single crochet 2 stitches together): Draw up a lp in each of next 2 sts, yo and pull through all 3 lps on hook.

Project Note

To change colors in sc: Draw up a lp in next st, drop working color, with new color, yo and pull through 2 lps on hook.

Abbreviations

beg – beginning; **ch** – chain; **lp** – loop; **mm** – millimeter; **rep** – repeat; **rnd(s)** – round(s); **sc** – single crochet; **sk** – skip; **st(s)** – stitch(es); **yo** – yarn over; **[]** – rep instructions inside brackets the number of times specified; * – repeat instructions after asterisk as specified.



GHOSTIE: Beg at top of head with A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook; do not join rnd, mark last st with a marker and move marker up with each completed rnd – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 7-14: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 15: Sc2tog around – 18 sc.

Rnds 16-19: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 20: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 21: Rep Rnd 20 – 32 sc.

Rnd 22: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 40 sc. Stuff head.

Rnd 23: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 24: * Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 56 sc.

Rnd 25: * Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 64 sc.

Rnd 26: * Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 72 sc.

Rnd 27: * Sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 80 sc.

Rnd 28: [Sk next 20 sc, sc in each of next 20 sc] twice – 40 sc.

Rnd 29: * Sc in each of next 8 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnds 30-32: Sc in each sc around, stuffing as work progresses.

Rnd 33: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 34: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 35: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 36: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 37: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnds 38 and 39: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 40: * Sc in next sc, sc2tog; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnds 41 and 42: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 43: Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Rnds 44 and 45: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" end. Weave end through rem sts and pull to draw sts closed.

With B, embroider oval eyes and mouth as shown in photo.

SCARF: With C, ch 61.

Row 1: 2 sc in second ch from hook and in each of next 19 ch, sc in each of next 20 ch, 2 sc in each of next 20 ch; fasten off. Tie Scarf around neck.

CANDY CORN HAT: With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in second ch from hook – 6 sc.

Rnd 2: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 9 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 4: * Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Rnd 5: Sc in each sc around, changing to C in last sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 7: * Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 15 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 9: * Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: * Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 21 sc.

Rnd 12: * Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around, changing to D in last sc – 24 sc.

Rnd 13: * Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around – 27 sc.

Rnds 14 and 15: Sc in each sc around. Fasten off, leaving a 24" end. Stuff at lightly and use end to sew Hat to top of head.

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
