Dear Mr. Kim Tae Hwan,

We consider it necessary to appeal to you again on the matter concerning impossibility of holding the Third Delphic Games in the current concept. The main reason is that the preparation of the Games is being carried out on the basis of information which doesn't correspond to reality and therefore misleads representatives of state authorities, international organizations and artists of different countries.

Thus for example it is absolutely unacceptable to include persons which actively argues against holding this event in the current concept into the list of "co-organizers": the Chairman of the Board of the International Delphic Committee, the Chairman of the Board of the Ukrainian Delphic Committee, Ph.D., professor Leonid M. Novokhatko in his letter addressed to you, as of April 15, 2009 № 23/77-3 (a copy is attached), made an appeal not to hold the Games in such a form; despite this at the website of the Organizing Committee of the event www.delphic2009.com he is indicated among heads of national organizations which are forming delegations to the Games in Jeju. Besides Mr. Victor I. Voronkov stated as a representative of Russia has no legal basis to form a team of the country to the Games because in case of carrying out such activity he will violate juridically protected rights of the trade mark's holder – the National Delphic Council of Russia which is a member of the International Delphic Committee, etc.

Along with that the website www.delphic2009.com contains information that the First Delphic Games 2000 in Moscow were held by the International Delphic Council that also doesn't comply with reality. That event was organized by the National Delphic Council of Russia because of Mr. Christian Kirsch's irresponsible breach at the very last moment of all financial and organizational obligations that he undertook in respect to this event. The fact of withdrawal of state support to the Second Delphic Games which the authorities of Malaysia planned to grant because they had been misled is suppressed as well (a copy of the BBC announcement is attached). The fact of cancellation of the Games 2007 made by the state authorities of the South Africa is not announced either. Moreover the Youth Delphic Games 2003 in Düsseldorf which in fact were not held are widely publicized by the International Delphic Council as a successful event.

With this in view we consider it to be our duty to once again draw your attention that the ongoing preparation of the Third Delphic Games is being carried out on the basis of unreliable information that is being provided to you by the International Delphic Council and Mr. Christian Kirsch. In such conditions the result of the Games could not be positive. We call on you to take into consideration the facts stated in this letter and to restructure the event are being prepared to the form that will both enrich the world culture and show to the world the power of the culture of your country. Having the experience of holding the Delphic Games admitted by UNESCO and the Council of Europe (a copy of auspices letters is attached) we express our readiness to grant comprehensive assistance in case of need.
