Verb Dominoes - have, take and go

Divide the students into pairs. Each student takes six dominoes. The students take it in turns to match the verb and noun combinations. When a student matches a combination, they must make a sentence using the two words. If a student cannot go, they take a domino from the pack. The first student with no cards left is the winner.
