



Britain's total ground strength, including militia: 319,000. Regulars: 79,000 home; 163,000 abroad Militia: 77,000 home.

Small detachments of National Guard and Marines left to guard the coast.

30,000 British troops stationed in West Indies and Canada.

30,000 men were stationed in garrisons along Dwina and Dnieper rivers, intended as a reserve.

Scattered garrisons and depots contained 100,000 men

Spanish armed forces not shown.

4,500 British troops stationed at Cape of Good Hope.

25,000 British troops stationed in Ceylon and East Indies.
