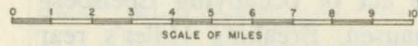

BATTLE OF EGMÜHL

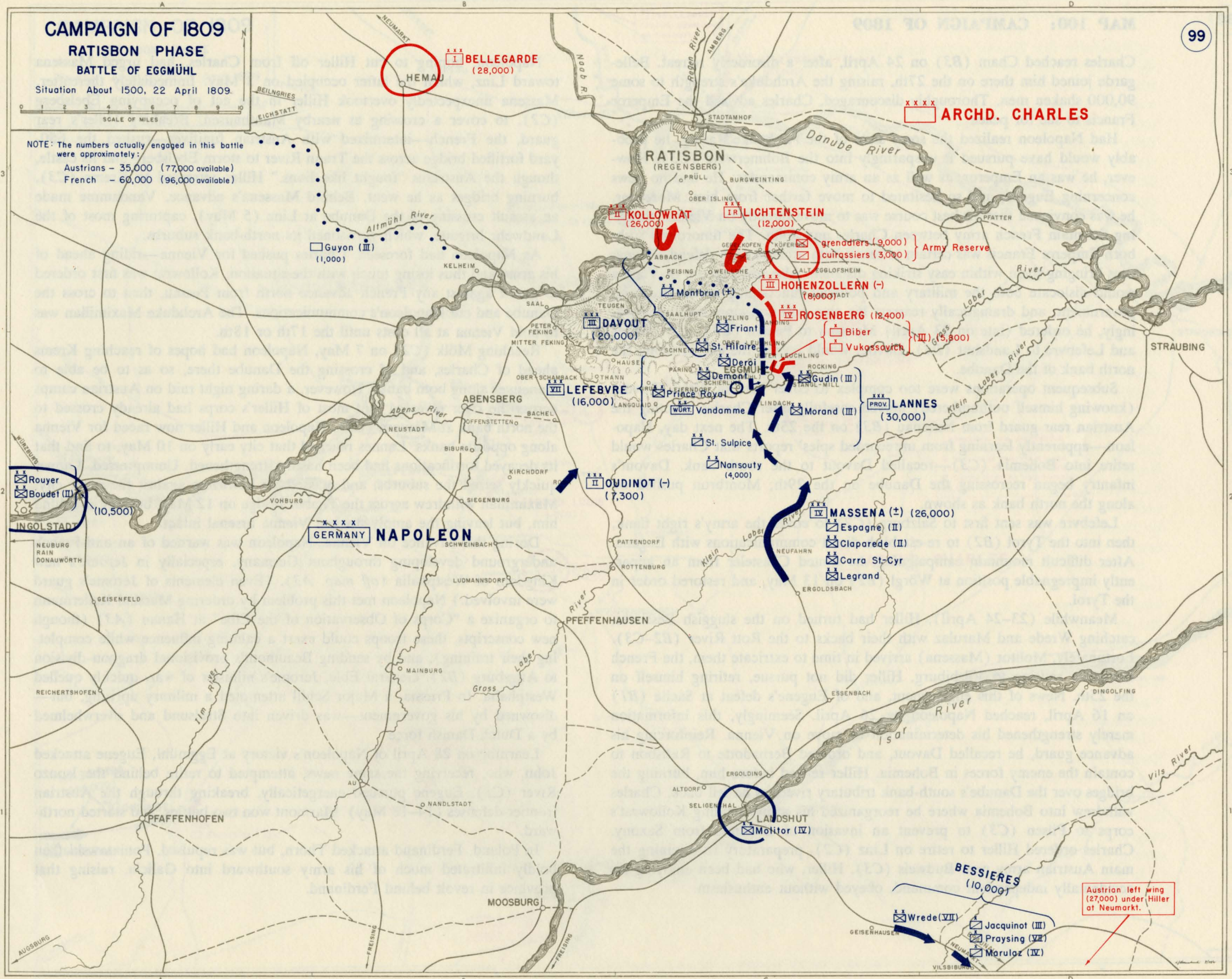
Situation About 1500, 22 April 1809
