Telecommunications Act, 2001 (Act 2001-36)

TELECOMMUNICATIONS (GENERAL RADIO-COMMUNICATION STATION LICENCE) REGULATIONS, 2003

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 110(1) of the *Telecommunications Act*, makes the following Regulations:

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications* (*General Radio-Communication Station Licence*) Regulations, 2003.
 - 2. In these Regulations,
- "radio-communication station" means a station that uses telecommunication by means of radio waves.
- **3.** A person who is desirous of keeping, installing or operating a general radio-communication station may
 - (a) on application to the Minister in the form set out in Part I of the *Schedule*; and
- (b) on payment of the relevant fee specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations*, 2003 _{No. 78.} obtain a licence for the purpose.
 - **4.** A licence issued under regulation 3
 - (a) shall be in the form set out in Part II of the *Schedule* and shall be schedule. subject to such conditions as are specified in the licence; and

- (b) is not transferable.

- **5.** Subject to regulation 6, a licence issued under regulation 3 shall expire on the 31st December following the date of issue and is renewable during the month of January in each year on payment of the relevant fees specified in the *Telecommunications* (*Licence Fees*) *Regulations*, 2003.
- **6.** Where the licensee fails to comply with any provision of these Regulations or with any of the conditions referred to in regulation 4, the Minister may cancel or refuse to renew the licence.

Requirements

It is a condition of every General Radio-Communication Station Licence that the licensee shall, if required by the Ministry in the interest of radio frequency spectrum economy or for any other reason, work with a common base station operated or licensed by the Ministry or to share a radio frequency with other stations, subject to any condition which the Ministry may impose.

For terms and conditions of the Licence, please see below.

A separate Licence is required for the use of Spectrum.

Application Procedures

Applicant should use the prescribed form "Application for General Radio-Communication Station Licence" (TU015), available from the Ministry and submit it to the Ministry.

Equipment

All radio equipment must be type approved by the Ministry responsible for Telecommunications in Barbados.

Licence Conditions

- 1. This Licence is issued in accordance with and subject to the Act and the Regulations, and shall remain valid for the duration of Licence, unless suspended or revoked by the Minister, in accordance with section 19 of the *Telecommunications Act* 2001-36.
- The Licensee hereby confirms that the information and any documents furnished and supplied for the purposes of applying for this Licence is true and accurate.
- 3. The Licensee and all the persons operating the Stations which the Licensee is authorized by this Licence to establish, install and operate, shall observe and comply with the Act, and the conditions of this Licence.
- 4. The Licensee shall not permit or cause any unauthorized person to operate the Stations or have access to the Stations and equipment installed therein. The Licensee shall ensure that persons authorized to operate the Stations observe the conditions of this Licence at all times.
- 5. The Stations shall be used only with the emissions at the frequency(s) of the class(es) and power respectively specified in this Licence.
- The Licensee shall ensure that the equipment installed in the Stations shall at all times comply with all applicable emission standards and requirements specified by the Ministry from time to time, in relation thereto.

- 7. The Licensee shall maintain up-to-date records of the list of the Stations, including the installation location of the Stations, name of equipment manufacturer, model, serial number of the equipment, frequency(s), output power, date of purchase and date of disposal of the equipment. This list shall be made available for inspection by the Ministry and when requested.
- 8. The Licensee shall permit or ensure that permission is granted to an authorized person of the Ministry upon production of proof of identity, to enter any building, premises, compound or other place, vehicle, vessel or aircraft where the Stations are installed or are being installed, to enable the said authorized person to inspect, examine or test any equipment installed in the Stations.
- 9. The equipment installed in the Stations shall be designed, constructed, maintained or used such that the Stations and Network, when used, shall comply with the Act and not cause interference to any other licensed or authorized stations or networks or telecommunication installation or equipment which may be lawfully owned, used or operated by any other person. The Licensee shall permit an authorized officer of the Ministry to inspect the equipment installed in Stations in order to determine whether the interference is in fact caused by the said equipment.
- 10. The Minister may suspend, revoke, modify or refuse to renew a licence in accordance with section 62 of the *Telecommunications Act* 2001-36.
- Unless authorized in writing by the Ministry, the connection of any equipment installed in the Stations and Network to the Public Switched Telecommunications Network (PSTN) will not be permitted.

- 12. The Licensee shall notify the Ministry of any intended change of address of the Licensee or any proposed change in any of the equipment installed in the Stations or any proposed change in the operating radio frequency(s), the mode of transmission or usage, the location at which the Stations are installed, and before such change is effected, the Licensee shall obtain the prior written approval of the Ministry.
- 13. The Licensee and persons authorized by the Licensee to operate the Stations shall ensure that the Stations and the equipment installed therein are not used for unlawful purposes or misused in any way.
- 14. The Licensee shall ensure that the Stations and Network, including the equipment installed therein, the operating radio frequency(s) and the location at which the Stations are installed are not tampered with or modified in any manner unless the Ministry's written approval has been obtained. As and when directed by the Ministry, the Licensee shall, at its own cost, conduct inspections on the equipment in order to satisfy the Ministry that the equipment has not been tampered with or modified.
- 15. The Stations and this Licence shall be available for inspection at all reasonable times by any duly authorized officer of the Ministry.
- 16. When the Licensee ceases to operate the Stations or where this Licence ceases to be valid, the Licensee shall return the licence to the Ministry for cancellation and the Ministry may require the Licensee to seal, disable or dismantle the equipment installed in the Stations in the presence of any authorized Ministry officer.
- 17. The Licensee shall not possess any radio-communication equipment, except and in accordance with a licence granted under section 60 of the *Telecommunications Act 2001-36*.

- 18. The Licence Application Fee shall be paid in advance and shall not be refundable.
- 19. This Licence is not transferable except with the prior written approval of the Ministry.
- 20. The Licensee shall comply with any directions or notifications which the Ministry may, from time to time, issue.
