It is painful to note that the victims who lost their lives in the chaotic election violence were subjected to torture and inhuman treatment. It is disappointing to realize that The National Peace and Reconciliation Commission (NPRC) which is mandated by the Constitution to look into all these issues has not yet been constituted amid worries that the time that this commission is supposed to be operational is quickly running out.

Heal Zimbabwe as an organization that seeks to promote peaceful coexistences in local communities appeals to the Government for the full operationalisation of the NPRC in order for it to deal with past cases of impunity in the country and campaign for a Never Again stance on political violence.
