Friedman states that in Journy 19 7 We John i he welish Jourity Police. First he was active in Radon, where he bla ned the arrest of leading "Volksdeutsche" (formand cubide 1919 frontiers) who had assisted in the exterminablen of the laws. Later he was transferred to Danzig, given the rack of Lieutenant and a tached to the "Eighth Bureau" for German Affairs unde mar 1 Morezynski. His main RESERVE duby was to locate S.S. and destapo men sho had gone underground in the Danzig neighbourhood, In the course of two months he jailed about a thousand of them.

In 1946 he was called in by the European Section of the Magana Intelligence Service and charged with being in ichmann. A group of five Jewish students was formed for this outpose, who were unable to trace Fichmann himself, but succeedes in old ining his photograph and certain documents relating to him.

After the search for war originals had receded before the more insections immediate needs of achiring arms for Targel and of the ar of Independence, Friedmann sittled in Helfa and jot up a Centre for Locumentation which so lacted door ents and data on many Razi war criminals, but always concentrated on Fichmann. For a time the Centre was supported by the world Jewish Congress; a couple of years ago the longress stopped his allocation and liment Rept the Centre coing out of what his wife earned inxherx by her work as a doctor. For the last ten years he has been exchanging information with the State Prosecutor of Baden, who informed him six months are that Dichmann had been traced to Kuwait. Richard Friedman informed the Israel authorities, and promised to "bring back Eichmann's head" if he was given a free hand and four men to help him. The request was turned down. Last October he gave the Kuweit item to the press, in the hope -- justified by events -- that the hunt for ichmann would be taken up again. Shortly before the elections in Begin Hovember last year he asked the Prime Minister to set a crize on Michmann's head.
