of Cluster lexamined Bundle No. 4 of Jasked us to check. the EICHMANN documents which After close scrutiny, he concluded data Bundle No. 4 was probably a false document for the following reasons:

- Is knowledge, To the best of he has never seen anything to indicate that EICHMANN had been concerned with Weltanschauliche Gegner. Yet he is listed as Chief of this Section (4-a).
- b. By 1944, and probably earlier, the Germans had exhausted their supply of official paper which gave the name of the office in print across the top of the page. They then began typing the name of the office in the upper left-hand corner of the page. Furthermore, he has never seen a German document which gives the subject and section in the center of the page above the name of the office. Zum beispiel:

- c. On the last page, last paragraph, the past tense wurden is used instead of werden which reads agents "were sent" instead of "are being sent". The last paragraph is also narrative as opposed to the other sections which are descriptive.
- d. Since the Leiter of this section in the last paragraph, which is dubious, is HALMANSEGER. I thinks the East Germans may have HALMANSEGER as a target. Therefore, name traces should be run on him, as well as all the other names, in order to determine why the East Germans would have used this document if it is not a true copy.
