

Inner West Community Transport's New Premises

Inner West Community Transport is proud to announce that we have officially moved into a new premises located at 40 Augusta Street Strathfield called The Dutton Centre.

The location was formally the Strathfield Bowling Club and following its closure after more than 50 years of operation the building was renovated with a \$495,000 capital grant from ADHC.

Inner West Community Transport won the bid to be the tenants in this newly renovated community centre along with Homebush Strathfield Meals on Wheels. The facility has been built to high quality standards and includes multiple common areas, meeting room, offices and vast open outdoor spaces.

In terms of transport the most impressive area of this complex is the brand new off street car park. This area is dedicated to Inner West Community Transport and has a newly erected security fence around its perimeter. The car and bus parking space has now increased significantly and given Inner West Community Transport the opportunity to grow and development over the coming years.

As we move toward the changes in the aged care model from 2015, securing adequate premises with off street fleet garaging has become a priority for many community transport organisations. This type of premises is not always easy to come by and it hasn't come without many years of searching.

The management committee, manager and staff of Inner West Community Transport would like to express its gratitude to all those involved in making The Dutton Centre what it is today, especially Strathfield Council and the Department of Aging, Disability and Home Care.
