



Prism Wild Stuff Scarf

Materials: 1 hank Light Stuff by Prism Yarns, 3-3.5oz/200 yds; #9 32" circular needle; crochet hook.

Stitches Used: Stockinette: knit on right side, purl on wrong side. Reverse stockinette: purl on right side, knit on wrong side.

Cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: (RS) Kfb, yo, k1, yo, kfb.

Row 2: (WS) Kfb, knit to last stitch, kfb.

Row 3: (RS) Kfb, yo, knit to last stitch, yo, kfb.

Row 4: (WS) Kfb, purl to last stitch, kfb

Rows 5-20: Repeat rows 3 & 4. Remembering that you can reverse stockinette as needed for the fluffy yarns.

Rows 21& 22: Using knitted cast on method, cast on 5 stitches at beginning of each row then continue in pattern as established in rows 3 & 4.

Rows 23-30: Repeat rows 3 and 4.

Row 31 & 32: Using knitted cast on method, cast on 10 stitches at beginning of each row then continue in pattern.

Rows 33-40: Repeat rows 3 and 4.

Rows 41 & 42: Using knitted cast on method, cast on 10 stitches at beginning of each row then continue in pattern.

Rows 43-45: Continue in pattern.

Bind off.

Finishing: Use crochet hook to pull yarn ends into back of work. Cut remaining yarn into 12" pieces; divide the number in half and use to make tassels for each end of scarf. Block with water or gentle steam.
