OUR AGM

FIRST AID COURSE

As members have already been informed, we have funding from the NHS for 3 people to attend a First Aid course. We have two signed up, but need a third. The person has to be willing to be present at our annual events like the Christmas Tree Celebration and ECO Day, but the knowledge of first aid will also be useful in a family situation or a street incident.

FUNDING UPDATE

On the subject of funding, we are continuing our efforts. We now have the help of the HEYCF group who will try to find us some funding from business. The Wyke Area Team wants us to have the full £60,000 for the Sensory Garden before any work commences so we need a funder like a business to be our sponsor. We have a National Lottery bid but in spite of our already turning in 10 pages of petitions they want to know how those signing the petitions will be involved in the creating and running of the garden. This is a difficult one, as, for example, the occupants of the three Residential Homes who signed petitions could not be expected to be out there digging!

In addition to this big sum, there are smaller grants we can access through Community First, a pot of money from central government. Unlike the Community Initiative Budget there is now a pot of money from central government called Community First which is administered by the community itself and there is an interim panel in place which I sit on. We will all step down in April and there will be elections for this panel which will decide on all applications.

Only community groups can apply. But since we have been told many times that we, The Friends. cannot do anything in Pearson Park without the permission of the trustees (the ward councillors) I thought we should get together with the trustees, decide what we can agree on and we can put in the funding application. So far I haven't had a response.

YOUNG FRIENDS GROUP

A **Young Friends of Pearson Park** group has been formed. This was Louise Muston's idea and she has organized it. She, I and Kath attended their first meeting on 28 January and Kath supplied the refreshments. We do not intend to run this group; they will run themselves and are already committed to PR and find-raising. We will publish more news as it develops.
