ORDINANCE No. 10 of 1899. (MERCHANT SHIPPING).

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42 (1) (c) of the Merchant Shipping Ordinance, 1899, as enacted by the Merchant Shipping Amendment Ordinance, 1935, the Governor in Council hereby amends Table S in the Schedule to the said Ordinance as follows:—

The following is substituted as the western boundary of the Victoria Anchorage for Junks as set out in Part I of the Table.

Western Boundary.—An imaginary line in continuation of Sai Kong Wharf (opposite Sutherland Street).
