Material:

- crochet hook size 2.5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in the colors black, green and brown
- fiberfill
- 2 Safety Eyes 6 mm/ 0.24 inches
- sewing needle
- 16 black beads

Size: The witch has a height of 15 cm / 5,91 inches

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st - stitch

R - round or row

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet (or a dc, hdc ...)

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

dcinc – make two double crochet in one stitch

sl st - slip stitch

sc with color change: change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

BLO – back loops only

FLO – front loops only

Picot: sc, 3 x ch, sc in first chain, **skip one stitch**, repeat

**Note:**

Unless indicated otherwise, parts are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring. It is important to mark the beginning of your round with a thread mark. Start to make the chin before you start with the body, because it is crocheted to the head.

Hands (2 x)

2 x ch with green

R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	6
R 02	(2 x sc, inc) x 2	8
R 03	sc in each stitch	8
R 04	sc in each stitch	8
R 05	(dec, sc) x 2, stuff the hand, dec	5
sl st, leave a long thread for the beads and cut the thread		

Shoes (2 x)

4 x ch with black

R 01	inc in second ch from hook, sc, 3 x sc in one stitch, continue working on the other side of the chain 2 x sc	8
R 02	2 x inc, sc, 3 x inc, sc, inc,	14
R 03	BLO: sc in each stitch	14
R 04	5 x sc, 4 x dec, sc	10
R 05	4 x sc, 3 x dec, stuff the shoe	7
R 06	3 x sc, 2 x dec	5
sl st, leave a long thread for the beads and cut the thread		

Chin

2 x ch with green

R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	6
R 02	(sc, inc) x 3	9
R 03	(2 x sc, inc) x 3	12
sl st, cut the thread		

Nose

2 x ch with green

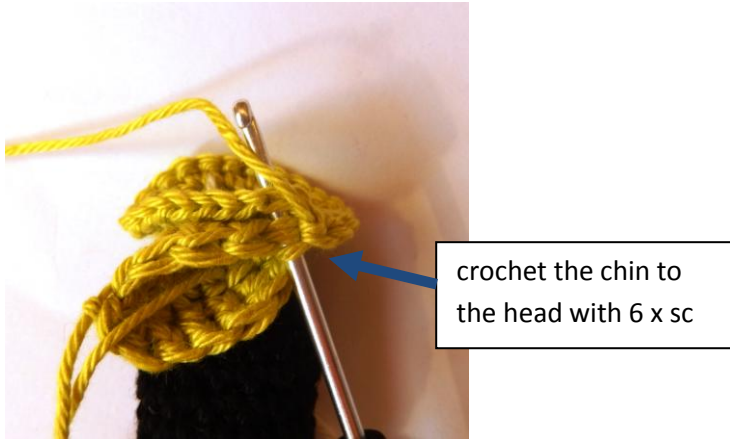
R 01	4 x sc in second ch from hook	4
R 02	inc, 3 x sc	5
sl st, cut the thread		

Body and Head

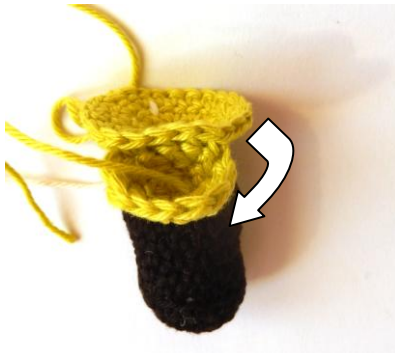

R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	(4 x sc, 2 x inc) x 2	16
R 04	sc in each stitch	16
R 05	BLO: sc in each stitch	16
R 06	sc, dec, 6 x sc, dec, 5 x sc	14
R 07	sc in each stitch	14
R 08	2 x sc, inc, 6 x sc, inc, 4 x sc	16
R 09	3 x sc, inc, 7 x sc, inc, 4 x sc	18
R 10	sc in each stitch	18
R 11	2 x sc, 3 x dec, 3 x sc, 3 x dec, sc with color change to green, stuff the body	12

R 12	sc, 2 x dec, 2 x sc, 2 x dec, sc	8

R 14	(sc, inc) x 4	12
R 15	inc in each stitch	24
R 16	10 x sc, now hold the chin to the head and crochet chin and head together with 6 x sc, s. picture, 8 x sc	24



R 17	in this round crochet over the outer side of the chin, s. picture 5 x sc, inc, (7 x sc, inc) x 2, 2 x sc	27
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R 18 - 19	sc in each stitch	27
R 20	13 x sc, put in a thread mark for the eye, 6 x sc, put in a thread mark for the second eye, 8 x sc	27
R 21 - 23	sc in each stitch	27
R 24	(7 x sc, dec) x 3	24
R 25	(2 x sc, dec) x 6, stuff the neck and the chin, plug in the Safety Eyes in R 20 (where you marked the position with a thread mark)	18
R 26	(sc, dec) x 6, stuff the head firmly	12
R 27	dec x 6	6
sl st, cut the thread and sew it		

Hat

2 x ch with black

R 01	4 x sc in second ch from hook	4
R 02	(inc, sc) x 2	6

R 03	(inc, 2 x sc) x 2	8

R 06	(5 x sc, inc) x 2	14

Finishing Hat and Hair

Cut 26 pieces of brown threads for the hair, each about 18 cm/ 7,09 inches long. Knot them into the back loops of R 15, s. pictures



Dress



Start crocheting in the back loops of R 05, in the back:

Sleeves (2 x)

2 x ch with black

R 01	6 x sc in second ch from hook	6
R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	(sc, inc) x 6	18
R 04	sc in each stitch	18
R 05	(sc, dec) x 6	12
sl st, cut the thread		

Cape

with black, crocheted in rows

6 x ch, turn

R 01	5 x sc, ch, turn	5
R 02	3 x ch (this is the first dc), 4 x dc, turn	5
R 03	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, dc, dcinc, dc, turn	7
R 04	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 3 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	9
R 05	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 5 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	11
R 06	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 7 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	13
R 07	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 9 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	15
R 08	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 11 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	17
R 09	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 13 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	19
R 10	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 15 x dc, dcinc, dc, turn	21
R 11	3 x ch (this is the first dc), dcinc, 17 x dc, dcinc, dc, ch, turn	23

Finishing



Sew on the nose, embroider the mouth and the eyebrows with brown wool.



Thread the beads to the arms and legs.



Sew on the arms: Insert the needle through the middle of the sleeve and then sew the arm to the body.



Sew the sleeves to the body with a black thread and then go ahead and sew the cape to the body.





Pull the dress up and sew the legs to the body.



Put on the hat with the hair and pin it, then sew the hat to the head.



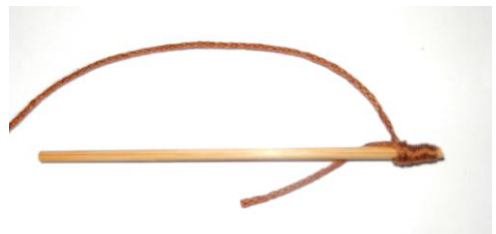
If you want, tie the hair in the back.

Broom

You need: wool rests in two different shades of brown and in color gray.

A wooden stick, about 12 cm / 4,8 inches, I took a shashlik-skewer and shortened it a little bit.

Wrap the wool around the wooden stick, wrap the beginning of the wool inside, see picture. Make a knot at the end or glue it.



Cut threads with a length of about 14 cm / 5,5 inches , then put the stick in the middle of the threads and fold it carefully.





Then firmly wrap the gray thread around the stick, knot the ends and hide them behind the gray wrapping.

Insert a needle through the center of the top, knot the ends together and then wrap the gray thread around the upper part of the broom. Now cut the ends of the bristles and the broom is finished – I wish you a nice flight ☺
