

FACILITIES UPDATE



FOOTBALL

- Currently undergoing the construction of a new 70,000-square-foot athletic training facility that will feature a state-of-the-art weight room, locker room, equipment room, football offices and team meetings rooms. Additionally, the third level will feature 302 outdoor club seats and an interior entertainment space.

BASKETBALL

- Installed new center-hung Daktronics high definition four-paneled videoboard, including LED stat boards and floor scoreboards.
- Remodeled women's basketball locker room, featuring new lockers, flooring, sound system, high definition video projection screen and player lounge.

BASEBALL

- Expanded baseball space, doubling its original size to include new locker room, player lounge and study area.
- Installed turf halo behind home plate with LATech logo.

SOFTBALL

- Constructed a 500-seat grandstand that includes a brand new press box.
- Located new home locker room and coaches offices right outside of the stadium.

SOCCER

- Installed new lights around the Lady Techster Soccer Complex to enable night games to be played for the first time.
- Improved field playability, including updated irrigation system, drainage and decorative retaining wall.

YEAR IN REVIEW



Men's basketball racked up a program record-tying 29 wins, including victories at Oklahoma and Georgia, won a second consecutive conference regular season title - this time as a member of Conference USA - and advanced to the NIT quarterfinals for just the second time in school history.

Golfer Victor Lange became the first Bulldog ever to earn a bid to the NCAA Regionals where he competed in the San Antonio Region and finished in the top 25 during the three-round event.

Women's basketball welcomed new head coach Tyler Summitt, son of legendary Tennessee Lady Vols head coach emeritus Pat Summitt. Tyler brings a new staff, including former Lady Techster and 35-year coaching veteran Mickie DeMoss.

Softball freshman Pauline Tufi earned all-state and all-CUSA honors after a stellar rookie campaign that saw her break the program single season freshman RBI record (34).

Baseball entered a new era with the hiring of Greg Goff. As the seventh head coach in program history, he recently led Campbell University to three straight 40-win seasons.

Football produced two NFL Draft picks last season in Justin Ellis (4th round, Oakland Raiders) and IK Enemkpali (6th round, New York Jets).

Men's track and field sprinter Trey Hadnot (200m, 4x100m relay) collected his sixth and seventh All-America honors.

Women's track and field star Charla Craddock swept the long jump titles at both the C-USA Indoor and Outdoor Championships while Kim Francis earned second team All-America honors in the 100m hurdles.





WHAT'S NEW FOR 2014-2015

Starting this year, there will be a number of exciting new changes to the structure and operation of LTAC. These changes have been made after careful consideration. They will allow Louisiana Tech Athletics the opportunity to responsibly plan for LTAC revenues in the coming years as we set our annual budget. This will maximize the positive impact on the student-athlete experience. Some important changes are outlined below:

ANNUAL GIFT DEADLINES

Beginning this year, all gifts and pledge payments must be paid in full by June 30th prior to the upcoming competition year in order to receive LTAC benefits such as parking passes, etc. If you are paying your pledge in multiple payments, we ask that you have your pledge paid in full by this time.

CHANGES IN GIVING LEVELS

In order to eliminate confusion, we have changed the structure and benefits of certain giving levels. The Booster Level will now be \$100-\$249, Varsity will now be \$250-\$499, and Champion will be \$1,000-\$2,499. In addition to these changes in levels, C parking passes will now only be distributed at the Trophy Level (\$500-\$999).






PREMIUM RESERVED PARKING

TERMS TO KNOW

Prospective Student-Athlete (PSA or "Recruit"): Any student who has started classes for the ninth grade.

Recruiting: Any solicitation of a prospect or the prospect's family by an authorized institutional staff member for the purpose of securing the prospect's enrollment and participation in athletics.

Student-Athlete: A student who presently is participating in intercollegiate athletics or has participated in intercollegiate athletics and is still receiving athletics aid.

Extra Benefit: An extra benefit is any special gift or arrangement provided to a student-athlete, or student-athlete's friend or family member, which is not available to the general LATech student body or the general population.

Social Media Reminder

Boosters may not initiate or "accept" friend requests of prospects on Facebook, but they can "follow" recruits on Twitter. Boosters should NEVER post on a recruit's "wall", reply to a "tweet", send them any kind of direct message, or take any other action that would constitute contacting any recruit.

PROSPECTIVE STUDENT-ATHLETES

NCAA rules prohibit boosters from engaging in recruiting activities.

Permissible Booster Activities:

- Continuing to have contact with an established family friend or neighbor who is a prospect. (Contact Compliance for a pre-existing relationship form – must submit to ensure eligibility of student-athlete.)
- Viewing a prospect's game on your own initiative.
- Receiving a call from a prospect only if the prospect initiates the call and it is not for a recruiting purpose.
- Notifying the LATech coaching staff of prospects.

As A Booster You May Not:

- Contact or call a prospect that you have not had a longstanding relationship with (the relationship must pre-date the ninth grade).
- Contact or call a prospect's parent, coach, principal, or counselor.
- Assist with the actual evaluation of talent at the direction of the coaching staff.
- Promote LA Tech Athletics in any way to encourage a prospect to attend Louisiana Tech University.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHY IS MY PLEDGE PAYMENT DUE IN FULL BY JUNE 30?

To maintain the department's goal of responsible fiscal planning, it is important that we can accurately project and plan our budget. Since LTAC gifts are a crucial part of our annual budget, having this revenue secured at the end of our fiscal year allows us to responsibly project our expenses for the upcoming year.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T MAKE MY PLEDGE PAYMENTS IN FULL BY JUNE 30?

It is important that you meet this deadline to ensure that you retain your LTAC benefits such as football and men's basketball parking. Due to the high demand of these benefits, it is crucial that we ensure fair treatment to all LTAC members who meet these deadlines.

CAN I PAY MY LTAC GIFT IN INSTALLMENTS?

Yes. A variety of payment options are available as long as your pledge is paid in full by June 30. We will work to accommodate your requests in regard to your payment schedules.

CAN I JOIN LTAC IF I DON'T HAVE SEASON TICKETS?

Absolutely. LTAC membership is one of the best ways to show your support to more than 400 Louisiana Tech student-athletes.

DOES MY LTAC DONATION GUARANTEE I WILL HAVE A PARKING SPOT AT FOOTBALL GAMES?

Due to the high demand for this benefit, we cannot guarantee parking spots will be available in any of our lots. We will make every effort to accommodate all LTAC members who have a parking pass, until the lots fill up. The best way to make sure your spot will be available is to arrive early and enjoy the gameday atmosphere.
