What is it?

- Custom tabulation providing in-depth labor force characteristics of individuals with a disability
- 49 tables
- Shows the disability status and diversity of the labor force and population 16 and over
- Based on ACS three-year data file 2008-2010
- Sponsoring Federal agencies:
 - Department of Labor:
 - Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP)
 - Office of Federal Contracting Compliance Programs (OFCCP)

Importance of the Disability Employment Tabulation

- Allows examination of labor force diversity by disability status
- It is the source for detailed occupational statistics by disability status in the workforce for local areas
- First product from the Census Bureau providing in-depth labor force characteristics of individuals with a disability, with more detail on occupation, education, and earnings
- Provides reliable and accurate data to further education, research, and policy initiatives that improve employment opportunities and outcomes for individuals with disabilities

Highlights

- Over 1 billion estimates
- More than 4000 unique geographic entities:
 - U.S. Total
 - 50 states, D.C. and Puerto Rico
 - Metro/micro areas
 - EEO County Sets
 - Public Use Microdata Areas (PUMAs)
- Tables may include employment status, detailed occupation, occupation groups, citizenship, educational attainment, age, race, sex and earnings
- All tables show estimates, percentages, margins of error
- Fully available online through American FactFinder

Uses of the Tabulation

- **Users:** governments (state, federal, and regional), businesses, individuals
- Examine the diversity of the labor force, by disability status, for many levels of geography to support user needs:
 - State governments may **evaluate state policies**
 - Local communities may **study employment and labor force diversity** within their county or metro area
- **Identify human capital gaps** for individuals with disabilities using information on education level, as well as occupation
- **Assess equal pay issues** for individuals with a disability using information on earnings by employment status, comparing across
 - Occupation
 - Race, Hispanic origin, gender, and citizenship
 - Geographies

Content and Key Concepts

Source Data: American Community Survey (ACS)

- The largest survey in the United States with a sample size of about 3½ million household addresses annually
- Monthly data collection that yields aggregate estimates every year
- Fully implemented in 2005
- Collects data on a wide range of demographic, social, economic, and housing characteristics
- Includes all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico

3-Year Estimates

- Period estimate rather than point-in-time estimate
- Information collected continuously from independent monthly samples over 36 months (January 2008 through December 2010)
- Aggregated results over period
- Describes no specific day, month, or year within period
- Cumulative sample allows measurement of characteristics in local geographies and increases precision of its estimates
- Best source for detailed occupation by disability, race and ethnicity, and sex for local areas

Margins of Error

- All estimates of number and percent include margins of error (MOE's)
- Check margins of error to ensure estimates have sufficient reliability for their intended use
- Based on a 90-percent confidence level
- Use the pre-calculated estimates and margins of error when available for totals and subtotals

Disclosure Avoidance

- Census Bureau bound by strict laws to protect confidential information
- Disclosure Review Board approved
- Estimates are rounded
- Population thresholds for some sub-state geographies
- Tables have at least 3 unweighted cases per cell
 - CBSAs and County Sets only
 - Smaller cells suppressed to protect identity of individuals
 - Used complementary suppression
 - Suppressed cells denoted with “N”
- Empty tables (no data) not displayed

- 49 tables total
- 7 Table Sets
 - (1) Detailed occupations
 - (2) EEO occupation groups
 - (3) EEO-1 job categories
 - (4) Federal sector job groups
 - (5) State and local government job groups
 - (6) Educational attainment by Age
 - (7) Employment status and Earnings for detailed occupations
- Crossed by disability status, sex, race/ethnicity, and citizenship (nation-level only)

Geography Notes

- Geography is at “residence,” covering people living in the area
- Includes Puerto Rico (PRCS) at sub-national level
- Population thresholds apply
 - 100,000 minimum for tables with Detailed Occupation
 - 50,000 minimum for tables without Detailed Occupation
 - National level only for tables showing Citizenship detail
- EEO County Sets 2010
 - Groups of counties with 50,000 or more population
 - Not available for Puerto Rico
- Public Use Microdata Statistical Area (PUMA)
 - Statistical entity based on Census 2000 geographies
 - Non-overlapping, partitioning each state into areas originally defined as covering minimum of 100,000 people
 - Same as those on ACS PUMS 2008-2010

Measurement of Disability

- Disability status measured by how respondents answered 6 questions on the American Community Survey
- If the individual is reported as having any type or multiple types of disability, then he or she is considered to have a disability
- The ACS attempts to capture six aspects of disability
 - Serious difficulty with four basic areas of **functioning** – hearing, vision, cognition, and ambulation
 - Difficulty with selected **activities** from the Katz Activities of Daily Living (ADL) and Lawton Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL) scales – difficulty bathing and dressing, and difficulty performing errands such as shopping
- Current set of disability questions introduced on the 2008 ACS
- Comparisons of disability data from 2008 or later with data from prior years are not recommended
- The Disability Employment Tabulation does not show details on the type, severity, or duration of disability

ACS Questions on Disability

FOR ALL AGES:

- Is this person **deaf** or does he/she have serious **difficulty hearing**?
- Is this person **blind** or does he/she have serious **difficulty seeing** even when wearing glasses?

FOR THOSE AGE 5 AND OLDER:

- Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition, does this person have serious **difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions**?
- Does this person have serious **difficulty walking or climbing stairs**?
- Does this person have **difficulty dressing or bathing**?

FOR THOSE AGE 15 AND OLDER:

- Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition, does this person have **difficulty doing errands alone** such as visiting a doctor's office or shopping?



Comparison to Other Surveys

- American Community Survey (ACS)
 - Six questions / “Core” definition
 - Exclusively activity-based
- Current Population Survey Annual Social and Economic Supplement (CPS ASEC)
 - Work disability measure
 - Activity (work) and program-based
 - Core definition also available from Core CPS instrument
- Survey of Income and Program Participation (SIPP)
 - 60+ questions / “Comprehensive” definition
 - Combines both medical and activity-based
 - Includes measurement of severity

Use of ACS for Disability Employment Tabulation

- Strengths
 - Very large sample size (250,000+ addresses/month)
 - Households and Group Quarters covered
 - Allows study of smaller geographic areas
 - Timely, continuous
 - Includes demographic, social, and economic characteristics
- Weaknesses
 - Less detailed definition compared to SIPP
 - Questions changed in 2008, reducing sample to 3 years and limiting historical data (also true of monthly CPS data)

There are 8 race/ethnicity categories

Race 'alone' means the person reported one race

'Balance of Not Hispanic or Latino' includes the balance of non-Hispanic individuals who reported multiple races or reported Some Other Race alone

Table Set 6 is split by race/ethnicity groups: **Part 1** (first 5) and **Part 2** (last 4)

Table 7C has no race detail; shows sex in the columns instead



Occupation

- Based on 2010 Standard Occupational Classification (SOC)
- 488 Census detailed occupations (same as for ACS 2010 PUMS)
- Detailed occupations also grouped into 4 different aggregated occupations
- “Unemployed” occupation
 - Different from “Unemployed” employment status, so is not shown on Table Set 7
 - Currently unemployed and either no work experience in the last five years or last job was military-specific (e.g., military officer)
 - Does not include those currently unemployed and had a non-military-specific job (e.g. aircraft pilot) in the last five years; these records tabulated for the most recent job

Employment Status and Earnings

Table Set 7

- Employment status is current, refers to week prior to survey
- Three labor force statuses:
 - Employed
 - Unemployed
 - Not in the labor force
- Earnings are for past 12 months, in inflation-adjusted to 2010 dollars
- Earnings detail differs by employment status:
 - Total Population and Employed: 8 categories, combined above \$100,000
 - Unemployed and Not in Labor Force: 3 categories, combined above \$15,000

The Disability Employment Tabulation 2008-2010 (3-year ACS data) is available through American FactFinder (AFF) (factfinder2.census.gov) beginning March 14, 2013. This 49-table tabulation, which shows the disability status and diversity of the labor force and population 16 and over, is based on the American Community Survey (ACS) three-year data 2008-2010 (www.census.gov/acs). The Census Bureau produced this tabulation for two sponsoring Federal agencies: the Department of Labor's Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) and Office of Federal Contracting Compliance Programs (OFCCP).

The Disability Employment Tabulation 2008-2010 provides over 1 billion estimates showing the disability status and diversity of the labor force and population 16 and over for more than 4000 unique geographic entities. The Tabulation has similar content to that found in the Equal Employment Tabulation, and provides in-depth labor force characteristics of people with a disability, with more details on occupation, education, and earnings. Tables may include employment status, detailed occupation, occupation groups, citizenship, educational attainment, age, race, sex and earnings. The Disability Employment Tabulation shows estimates for the U.S. total, states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico, metro/micro areas, EEO County Sets, and PUMAs. All tables also include estimates, percentages, and margins of error.

Occupation describes the kind of work a person does on the job. Data were derived from answers to the following questions on the American Community Survey (ACS) questionnaire- "What kind of work was this person doing?" and "What were this person's most important activities or duties?" These questions were asked of all people 15 years old and over who had worked in the past 5 years. For employed people, the data refer to the person's job during the previous week. For those who worked two or more jobs, the data refer to the job where the person worked the greatest number of hours. For unemployed people and people who are not currently employed but report having a job within the last five years, the data refer to their last job.

The complete Census 2010 Occupational Classification System consists of 539 detailed categories, including four military-specific occupations. Due to the U.S. Census Bureau's Disclosure Review Board Requirements for the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) tabulation, any occupational category containing fewer than 10,000 people employed nationwide cannot be shown separately and must be combined with related occupational categories to create aggregates containing 10,000 or more people. In the EEO Tabulation there are 487 detailed occupation codes included in the worksite and worksite/residence tables, and 488 detailed occupation codes in the residence tables. The residence geography tables include an "unemployed, no work experience in the last 5 years or most recent job was in a military-specific occupation" category.

The Census classification is based on the 2010 Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) and arranged into 23 major groups. Occupation categories are listed by both the Census occupation code and the equivalent 6-digit SOC code. When a Census code does not have a single matching SOC equivalent, the SOC code shown may contain alpha characters, such as "11-10XX" with a description of the SOC codes combined included. 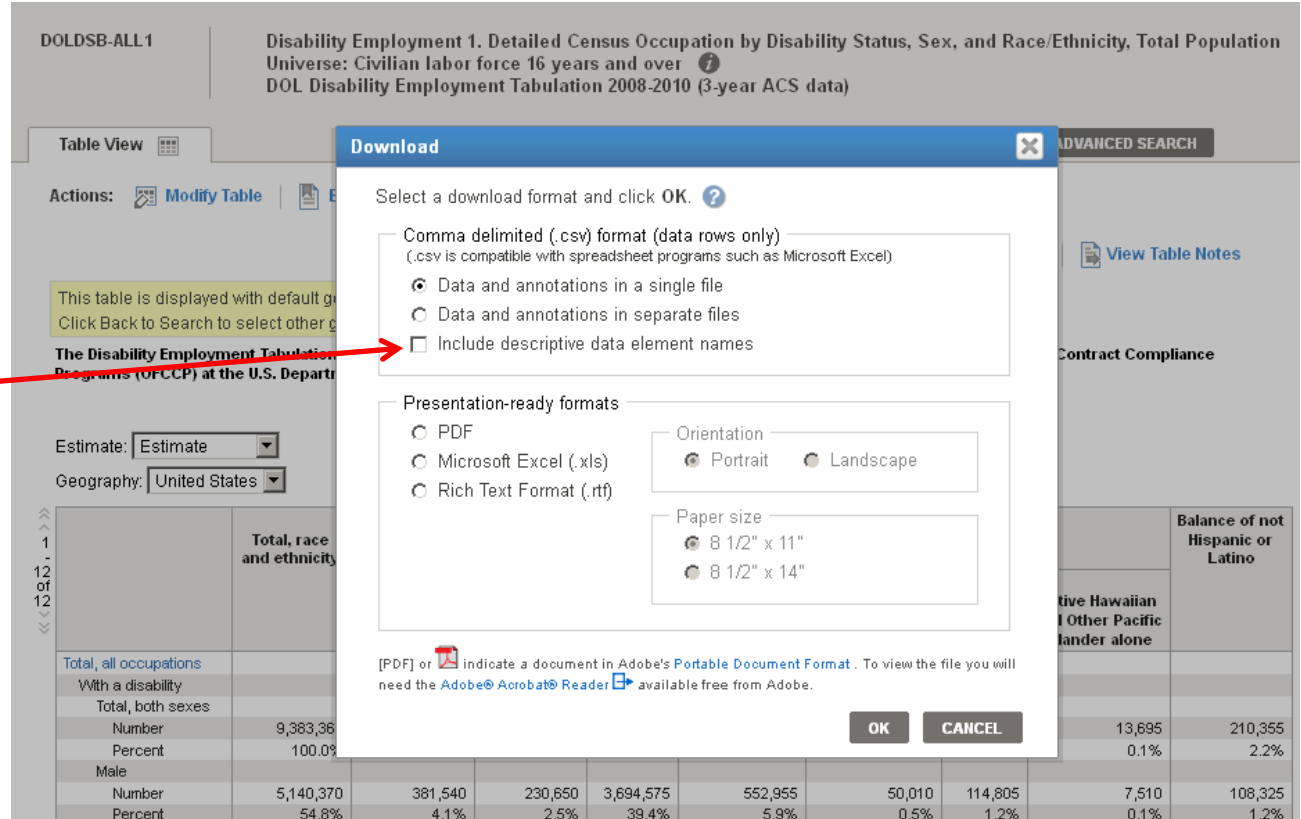
