

## Double Breasted Jacket (intememdiat)

MEASUREMENTS - Months 6 (12-18)
Fits underarm 45 (50-55) cms/18 (20-22) ins
To measure (approx) 50 (56-60) cms/20 (22-24) ins
Length (approx) 31 (35-37) cms/12 (14-15) ins
Sleeve length 16 (19-21) cms/6 (71/2-8) ins

## PANDA BABINDA YARN

$5(6-7) \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls

## NEEDLES

A pair each 6.00 mm (US 10), (UK 4) and 5.50 mm (US 9), (UK 5) Knitting Needles or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; 4 Buttons; Crochet Hook for Cord; Pom Pon Maker.

## TENSION/GAUGE

14 sts and 21 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Knitting Needles. Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit. This garment has been worked on smaller needles than normally recommended.

## ABBREVIATIONS

St/s - stitch/es, K - Knit, P - Purl, RS - right side, WS - wrong side, stocking st -1 row K, 1 row P, beg - begin/ning, patt - pattern, rep - repeat, incl inclusive, dec - decrease, yfwd - yarn forward to make a st, K2tog - knit 2 sts together, foll - follow/ ing, alt - alternate, rem - remain/ing, tog - together, inc - increase, cont - continue, sl - slip, psso - pass slipped st over.

## CREATE

## Back

Using 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Needles, cast on 38 (42-46) sts.
Beg border patt - 1st row (RS) - * K1, Pl, rep from * to end.
2nd row - * K3, P1, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.
3rd row - P2, * K1, P3, rep from * to end.
4th row - As 1st row.
5th row - * K1, P3, rep from * to last 2 sts, K1, P1.
6th row - $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{P} 1$, * $K 3, \mathrm{P} 1$, rep from * to end.
Rows 1 to 6 incl form border patt.
Change to 5.50 mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles.
Work in stocking st until work measures 16 (19-20) cms/6 (7-8) ins from beg, ending with a purl row.
Eyelet row - K2, * yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Next row - Purl.
Beg patt - Work 6 rows border patt (as before).
Shape armholes - Keeping patt correct, cast/ bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows $=34(38-42)$ sts.
Dec one st at each end of next row and foll alt row $=30$ (34-38) sts.
Cont in patt without shaping until armhole measures 12 (13-14) cms/5 (5-5½) ins, working last row on WS.
Shape shoulders - Cast/bind off $4(5-5)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows, then $4(4-5)$ sts at beg of foll 2 rows.
Cast/bind off rem 14 (16-18) sts.

## Right Front

Using 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Needles, cast on 26 (30-34) sts.
Beg border patt - Work 6 rows border patt as for Back.
Change to 5.50 mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles. **
Next row - K1, P1, knit to end.
Next row - Purl to last 2 sts, K1, P1.
Rep last 2 rows until work measures same as Back to eyelet row, working last row on WS.
Eyelet row - K1, P1, K1, * yfwd, K2tog, rep from * to last st, K1.
Next row - Purl to last 2 sts, K1, P1.
Beg patt - Work 7 rows border patt as for Back.
Shape armhole - Keeping patt correct, cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next row $=24$ (28-32) sts.
Next row - Patt 3, yfwd to make a st, patt 2 tog (buttonhole), patt 5 (7-11), yfwd to make a st, patt 2 tog (buttonhole), patt to last 2 sts, K2tog.
Next row - Patt to end.
Next row - Patt to last 2 sts, K2tog $=22$ (26-30) sts.
Work 7 (7-9) rows patt.
Next row - Patt 3, yfwd to make a st, patt 2 tog (buttonhole), patt 5 (7-11), yfwd to make a st, patt 2tog (buttonhole), patt to end $=4$ buttonholes in total.
Work 3 rows patt.
Shape neck - Next row (RS) - Cast/bind off 14 (1720) sts, patt to end $=8$ (9-10) sts.

Cont in patt until armhole measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with same patt row on WS.
Work 1 row patt.
Shape shoulder - Cast/bind off 4 (5-5) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row.
Cast/bind off rem 4 (4-5) sts.

## Left Front

Work as for Right Front to **.
Next row - Knit to last 2 sts, $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{~K} 1$.
Next row - $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{~K} 1$, purl to end.
Next row - Knit to last 2 sts, $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{~K} 1$.
Rep last 2 rows until work measures same as Back to eyelet row, working last row on WS.
Eyelet row - K1, * K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 3 sts, K1, Pl, K1.
Next row - P1, K1, P1, purl to end.
Beg patt - Work 6 rows border patt as for Back.
Shape armhole - Keeping patt correct, cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next row $=24$ (28-32) sts.
Dec one st at armhole edge in every foll alt row twice $=22$ (26-30) sts.
Work 12 (12-14) rows patt.
Shape neck - Next row (WS) - Cast/bind off 14 (17-20) sts, patt to end $=8$ (9-10) sts.
Cont in patt until armhole measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with same patt row on WS.
Shape shoulder - Complete as for Right Front.

Sleeve (make 2)
Using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles, cast on 22 (2226) sts.

Beg border patt - Work 6 rows border patt as for Back.
Work in stocking st for rem, inc one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 8th (8th-12th) row until there are 28 (30-32) sts.
Cont without shaping until work measures 16 (1921) $\mathrm{cms} / 6(\mathbf{7} 1 / 2-8)$ ins from beg, ending with a purl row.
Shape top - Cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 24 (26-28) sts.
Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 8 sts rem.
Cast/bind off loosely.

## Collar

Using 5.50mm (US 9), (UK 5) Needles, cast on 46 (5054) sts.

Beg border patt - Work 12 rows border patt as for Back.
Next row - K1, P1, * sl 1, K2łog, psso, P1, rep from * to end $=24$ (26-28) sts.
Next row - * K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Keeping rib correct, cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows.
Cast/bind off rem 16 (18-20) sts loosely in rib.

## FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.
Using yarn needle and mattress st seam, join shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Using a flat seam, sew collar in position to neck edge, beg and ending half way along side edge of neck. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes and fasten. Using a crochet hook, make a length of chain approx 75 (82-90) cms/30 (33-36) ins long. Thread chain cord through eyelet holes, beg at right front edge and ending where right front overlaps. Make 2 large pom pons and attach securely to each end of chain cord.
