


Harakat al-Shabaab al-Muiahideen in or rded worldwide, with only a negligible increase in the grou rational tempo from 2014. While Al-Shabaab maintai ations across the year against domestic security for d AMISOM peacekeepers, the group also periodically urundian peacekeepers in an assault on their base in June.
