

BETC Court Courtesies

Thanks you for choosing BETC for your tennis play. For those of you who are unfamiliar with our facility or tennis etiquette here are a few reminders to follow:

1. When entering the club please, keep your voice low, and do not distract ongoing matches.
2. Sportsmanlike conduct is expected at all times. Physical or verbal abuse of other players, staff, or facility is not acceptable.
3. Players must wear proper tennis clothing and (tennis) court shoes.
4. Unless for an emergency, cell phones shall remain turned off while participating at BETC.
5. Food or gum is not permitted on courts. Beverages should be in unbreakable, sealed containers. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products are allowed on the BETC property.
6. Three bells will ring to signal the beginning of your court time. Never cut across courts to get to your court, always use the walkways behind the backdrop.
7. A maximum of four players per court at all times. Extra players or spectators must wait in the viewing area or any other off court area. Only persons taking a lesson or renting a court may be on the court.
8. If a ball from another court comes onto your court please make eye contact with the other player before giving the ball back to them. Also, wait for them to stop playing before asking for a ball that has gone onto their court. If the court is being used, never go onto another court to retrieve your ball.
9. When play is done, leave the court area immediately.
