



What you will need:

RED HEART® Miami: 5 (6, 7, 7, 8) balls 00141 Peacock

Circular Knitting Needle: 3.75mm [US 5], 60 cm [24"] long.

Knitting Needle: 3.75mm [US 5], any type (for 3-needle bind-off).

Stitch markers, stitch holders, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 16 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 20 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Lace pattern. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

Cold Shoulder Pullover

Stay cool and fashionable in this bright knit sweater! It's perfect any season of the year.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, 1X and 2X are in parentheses.

Finished Bust: 91.5 (96.5, 101.5, 106.5, 112) cm [36 (38, 40, 42, 44)"].

Finished Length: 51 (52, 53.5, 56, 57) cm [20 (20½, 21, 22, 22½)"].

Special Technique

3-Needle Bind-off (seaming 2 pieces together as you bind off) Place stitches of pieces to be joined on separate needles or each end of a circular needle, hold one behind the other with right sides facing each other in left hand; with a third needle the same size, k2tog (1 from one needle and 1 from the other) – 1 st on right-hand needle, *ktog, in same manner, cast off; repeat from *.

Knit cast-on (casting on stitches at the beginning of a row) Start with slip knot or existing stitches. Knit 1 new stitch, but do not slide old stitch off left-hand needle. Insert left-hand needle under and into new loop on right-hand needle, slip stitch off right-hand needle — 1 stitch cast on.

Pattern Stitches Lace Pattern worked in rows (multiple of 8 sts)

Row 1 (Right Side): *K6, yo, k2tog; repeat

from * to end of row.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: *K2, yo, k2tog, k4; repeat from * to

end of row.

Row 6: Purl. Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Repeat these 8 rows for Lace pattern worked in rows.

Lace Pattern worked in rounds (multiple of 8 sts)

Note: Lace pattern worked in rounds looks the same as Lace pattern worked in rows. When worked in rounds, Right Side is always facing; even-numbered rounds are knit.

Round 1 (Right Side): *K6, yo, k2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 2-4: Knit.

Round 5: *K2, yo, k2tog, k4; repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 6-8: Knit.

Repeat these 8 rounds for Lace pattern worked in rounds.

Garter st worked in rows: Knit every row.

Garter st worked in rounds

Round 1: Purl.

Round 2: Knit.

Repeat these 2 rounds for Garter st worked in rounds.

Notes

- Pullover is worked in rounds to underarm.
 Front and Back are divided at sides and worked back and forth in rows.
- 2. Sleeve stitches are cast on at underarms when Front and Back are split.

LOWER BODY

With circular needle, cast on 144 (152, 160, 168, 176) sts. Join, place marker at beginning of round, and begin to work circularly.

Rounds 1-12: Work Garter st in rounds.

Rounds 13-14: Knit.

Work Lace pattern in rounds until piece measures 36 (36, 36, 38, 38) cm [141/4 (141/4, 141/4, 15, 15)"], end with round 2 or 6.

UPPER BODY AND SLEEVES

Divide for Front and Back.

Back and sleeves

Right Sleeve Increase Row (Right Side):

Using knit cast-on, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts for right sleeve, knit across sleeve sts, k72 (76, 80, 84, 88) sts for back—112 (120, 128, 136, 144) sts. Place remaining 72 (76, 80, 84, 88) sts for front on stitch holder.

Left Sleeve Increase Row (Wrong Side):

Using knit cast-on, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts; k8, purl to last 8 sts, k8—152 (164, 176, 188, 200) sts.

Next row (Right Side): K8, work next row of Lace pattern (Row 5 or Row 1) to last 8 sts, k8. Next row (Wrong Side): K8, purl to last 8 sts, k8

Repeat last 2 rows until sleeve measures 15 (16.5, 18, 19, 20) cm [6 ($6\frac{1}{2}$, 7, $7\frac{1}{2}$, 8)"] from cast-on edge, end with a WS row.

Next row (Right Side): K8, place on stitch holder; cast off 136 (148, 160, 172, 184) sts, k8, place on stitch holder.

Front and sleeves

Slip Front stitches from holder back to circular needle.

Left Sleeve Increase Row (Right Side): Using knitted-on cast-on, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts; knit across sleeve and front—112 (120, 128, 136, 144) sts.

Right Sleeve Increase Row (Wrong Side): Using knitted-on cast-on, cast on 40 (44, 48, 52, 56) sts; k8, purl to last 8 sts, k8—152 (164, 176, 188, 200) sts.

Next row (Right Side): K8, work next row of Lace pattern (Row 5 or Row 1) to last 8 sts, k8.

Next row (Wrong Side): K8, purl to last 8 sts, k8.

Repeat last 2 rows until sleeve measures 15 (16.5, 18, 19, 20) cm [6 ($6\frac{1}{2}$, 7, $7\frac{1}{2}$, 8)"] from cast-on edge, end with a right side row.

Join Cuffs

Slip Back right sleeve sts from holder to extra knitting needle. With right sides together, join right sleeve cuff sts using 3-needle bind-off. Cast off to last 8 sts; fasten off.


Slip Back left sleeve sts from holder to extra knitting needle. With right sides together, join left sleeve cuff sts using 3-needle bind-off.

FINISHING

Using schematic as guide, sew 1 " shoulder seams either side of neck, leaving sleeves open to wrist. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **k2tog** = knit 2 stitches together; **yo** = yarn over; ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.





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
