Property Description

A two storey building reached through a flight of steps running parallel to the façade and whose balustraded wall extends along the façade. The façade is symmetrical and austere. The entrance is through an elegant round headed doorway flanked on each side by a Doric column which extends to support the corbels of a wrought iron open balcony. A carved coat of arms underlies the balcony extending to include the scroll-shaped keystone of the doorway. The central doorway and balcony above it area flanked by a window at each floor level on either side, set within a recessed panel. The building is framed by a plain pilaster on either side and a cornice at roof level. The building is flanked on one side by a archway and a loggia above it.
